Best email address to reach you if an issue arises:

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- Students must be enrolled in 6 classes, regardless of the number of high school credits previously earned.
- Students need to reference the graduation requirements below when selecting classes. Students should select alternate course options for their electives that they would be willing to take in the event that one of their top choices fills up or is no longer going to be offered.
- 9th grade students who are interested in doing a Dual Enrollment (DE) course **MUST** meet the eligibility requirements listed below **before May 2023** to be eligible to take DE courses in the fall. Students taking a DE course online or through PHSC would have a “PHSC Off Campus Placeholder” on their schedule, and must have daily transportation. Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus placeholder. Off-campus placeholders must be at the beginning or end of the day. Students who meet eligibility requirements and plan to take a DE course must contact School Counselor (Ljoustra@pasco.k12.fl.us) about this request. Additional steps are required to participate in DE.

High School Graduation Requirements

- 24 credits, including:
 - 4 credits of English
 - 4 credits of Math
 - 3 credits of Science
 - 3.5 credits of Social Studies (Pers Fin Lit, World Hist, US Hist, US Gov/Econ)
 - 1 credit of Performing/Fine Art
 - 1 credit of Phys. Ed
 - 8 credits of Electives
- 1 online course
- 2.000 unweighted GPA
- Pass Alg EOC and Grade 10 FSA (or earn concordant score)

Dual Enrollment Requirements via PHSC

- Cumulative unweighted HS GPA 3.0 or higher
- Test Scores in Reading, Writing, and Math
 - PERT: Read 106, Writing 103, Math 114 **OR**
 - SAT: Read 24, Writing 25, Math 24 **OR**
 - ACT: Read 19, Writing 17, Math 21
- Maintain cumulative college GPA 2.0 or higher

Min. State University Admission Requirements**

- 3.0 GPA or higher
- SAT: Reading/Writing 500 & Math 500 **OR**
- ACT: Composite 18
- 2 credits of World Language (same language)
- Community Service
- Student Involvement (clubs, sports, etc.)
