



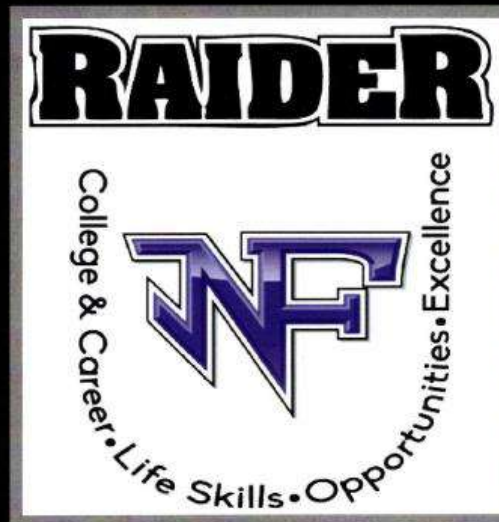

How to Select Elective Courses in Parent Portal/Infinite Campus

1. Log into your Parent Portal account. If you do not have a parent portal account, please contact the school you are currently attending.
2. If you have more than one child, please choose the student you wish to register first.
3. Click on Registration 2018/2019. Teachers have made recommendations for your student's academic core classes and any second or third level CTAE courses. These recommendations cannot be changed. However, you can submit an online course waiver, which is available on the NFHS website by clicking on the link located on our homepage.
4. To make elective choices, please refer to the 2018-19 Course Selection Sheet located in your packet. Students are responsible for reviewing the course digest for any pre-requisite requirements and specific information about each course prior to selecting their electives. The link to the Course Digest is available on the NFHS website.
5. Follow the prompt to add "Elective Course" and "Alternates". You must select a minimum of three alternates. Please understand that the Elective Courses and Alternates added to this list are requests only and are NOT your student's FINAL Schedule.
6. You may search by course name or by course number.
7. Students will not be able to register for an elective in which they have previously earned high school credit or in which they are currently enrolled.
8. If you wish to drop an elective course after you have selected it; click on the course and follow the prompt to drop it.

- o Students must have a total of 7 credits (70/70 in Parent Portal).
- o Year long classes are indicated with a "y" at the end of the course number.
- o Semester classes are indicated with an "s" at the end of the course number and must be paired with another semester class.
- o Course selection is not first come first serve. You can make elective selections and changes at any time during the OPEN portal dates.

Your middle school teachers have made the core academic course recommendations. Along with these core recommendations, all 9th grade students are required to take Personal Fitness/Health. You will be able to review your course recommendations in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. Your responsibility is to select your elective classes and a minimum of three alternate electives!

A description for all high school courses can be found in the 2018-2019 Forsyth County Course Digest. We strongly encourage you to utilize the information provided to make an informed decision regarding your final elective choices.

The Portal will **OPEN** on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 8:00 am and **CLOSE** on Wednesday, February 28, 2018 at 4:00 pm.

HELPFUL REMINDERS:

Students/Parents should select the number of elective courses to equal seven (7) classes and three (3) alternate classes. In parent portal you will see 70/70 when you have a complete schedule. If a course ends with a "y", this is a year-long course and counts as one class. If a course ends with a "s", this is a semester course, requiring you to select two courses to equal the full credit. (e.g. 60325s Drivers Education & 40475s World Geog.) Your schedule will be incomplete if you do not select two "s" classes.

If there is no course number but a teacher name, this course requires an application. These courses are noted with an (*). Please contact that teacher directly and/or visit the NFHS website for the application.

Parents must complete an on-line course waiver form if they disagree and wish to change a teacher's core course recommendation. The waiver will be available on the NFHS website under the Registration Link at 4:00 pm on Monday, March 5, 2018. All waivers must be submitted no later than 4:00 pm on Monday, March 12, 2018.





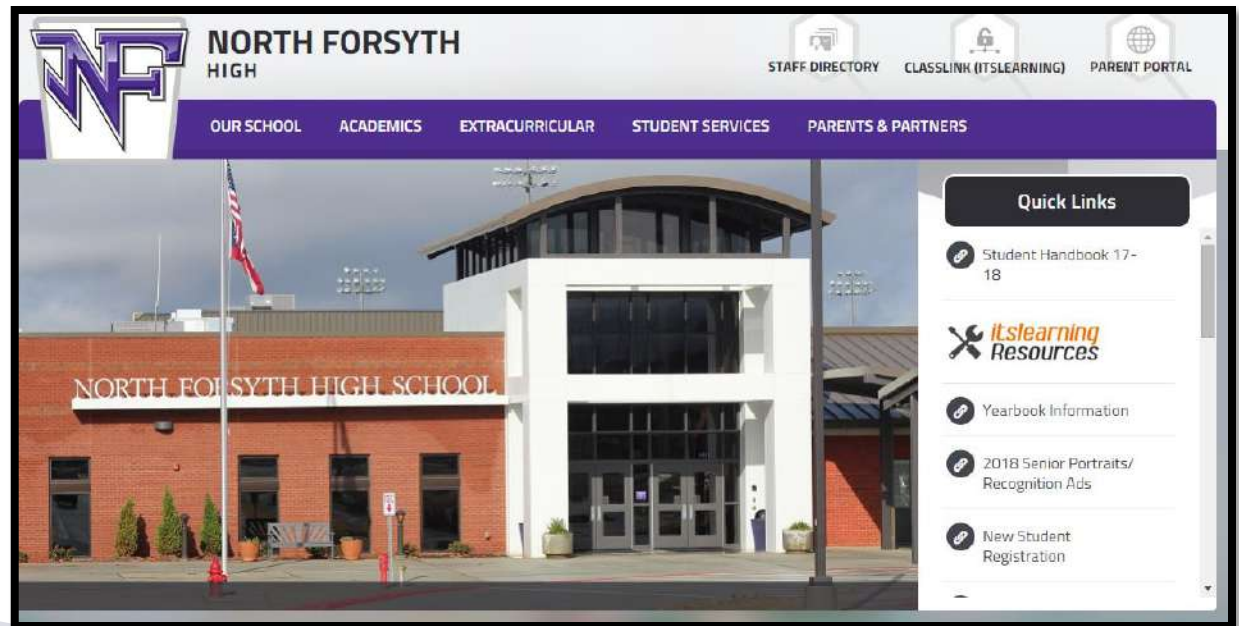
