

What We Are Learning

<u>ELA</u>-> We will work on close reading and using the acronym "RACE" to write good text evidence based responses. We will work on comparing two different texts on the same topic. We will also be working on grammar skills. <u>**Math</u></u>-> We will continue to work on multi-digit multiplication. This includes up to 4 digits by 1 digit and 2 digit by 2 digit multiplication. We will learn various methods to multiply. Continue practicing basic facts at home. We will begin working on division. Students will need to be able to divide a 4-digit number by a 1-digit number. Check out my webpage for helpful websites. We work on word problems on-going all year. Be sure your child can make sense of problems, strategize, and explain how they got their answers using words and/or pictures. <u>Science</u> -> Our focus in Science will be the Water Cycle. Students will need to know the states of matter and how water changes from solid to liquid to gas and vice versa. They need to know boiling and freezing temperatures of water. They will learn how clouds form, stages of the water cycle, and the types of precipitation. Social Studies** -> We will review European Explorers and Native Americans.</u>
