

WHAT IS FORM?

- Form is an element of art
- Forms are closed spaces
- Forms are either geometric or free form.

WHAT IS FORM?

- Form is 3 dimensional, meaning it has 3 sides.
- The 3 sides are called length, width and height.
- A shape is only 2 dimensional, with length and width
 - You combine shapes and lines to make forms.


Geometric Forms Include


- Cubes

- cones


Free Forms Include

- Pottery










MAKE YOUR OWN FREE FORM:
