"Measure 2: By year three of the charter, FSMA will meet or exceed the performance of the primary sending district high schools in the state assessments." DMA does not meet this yet for the Red Clay District after 5 or 6 years.

"Measure 3: By year three of the charter, FSMA will demonstrate its cadets perform at or above state average on the SAT." Again, not the case, with 2 out of 3 areas of the SATs being met. They don't meet the districts scores let alone the state averages. And well below the National Average.

The real question with these goals is, who is First State Military Academy going to target as their cadets. They will select the best from current programs and new Freshman. SEE STATS ABOVE FOR AN INDICATION ON WHO LOSES. With the current climate on budget cuts, AFJROTC going below the mandatory 100 cadets will be closed.
