# What is HOPE?

- HOPE is a graduation requirement course integrating concepts of physical education and health, focused on establishing healthy habits for life.
- Students who participate in TWO seasons of FHSAA athletics are eligible for a HOPE waiver
  - Let your counselor know at registration if you would like this option
- IB Diploma students are exempt from taking HOPE
- Students who plan to take HOPE on SJVS this summer must be approved by their CURRENT counselor



- World Language is **NOT** a graduation requirement
- Students who plan to attend college must take two years of the same world language.
- 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Students must be in English 1 Honors or Pre-IB English 1 to be eligible to start their World Language
- Languages offered on-campus at PMHS: **Spanish and ASL**
- Additional languages offered through FLVS/SJVS (students may take in a virtual lab during the school day): Latin, French, Chinese and Hebrew.

### **St. Johns Virtual School Off Campus- FORM REQUIRED**

1. The student is expected to register for and complete two semesters of a St. Johns Virtual School Course during the school year.

3. The student must have their own transportation and be off campus during the off-campus SJVS period.

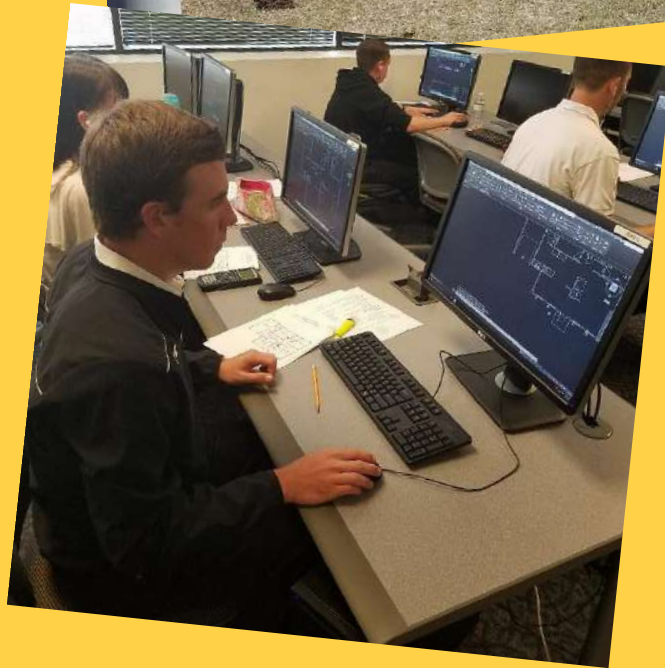

# College Credit

## Looking ahead...

### Dual Enrollment

- Must have a 3.0 Unweighted GPA
- Must take the PERT/ACT/SAT to qualify
- Classes occur on the PMHS campus, online as well as at the SJR campus and FCTC

### IB

- All 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> students can take an IB Class as a “Certificate” student and earn college credit for individual classes
- IB Certificate classes include: English, History, Science, Math, Spanish, Art, Dance, Business & Psychology





# **Registration Process**



## How to Prepare for Registration

1. Select electives in Home Access Center by Friday, Feb 26
2. Discuss core course selections with parent and current teacher (can be changed at registration appointment)
3. Be sure to have SEVEN classes chosen prior to your appointment
4. Schedule Request Review Windows

March 10-March 16	May 24-May 28
Students will have the opportunity to review registered courses in HAC and use the designated form to request changes	

**The seven classes selected at registration will determine the student's schedule for the 2021-2022 school year.**

**Course selections CAN NOT be changed after June 10.**

  - Individually Scheduled at other M.S. as needed
- Parents and Distance Learning students may attend the meeting via Zoom Link (will be sent out in letter with appt time)

# How to select electives in HAC

Step 1: Log into HAC

Step 2: Select “Classes” from the menu at the top of the screen



Step 3: Click the “Requests” Tab from the menu

Step 4: Select “Electives” and click “Edit”



Step 5: Choose THREE electives and one back-up option

Step 6: Click “Save” before exiting
