# What Makes Us Special

- Goldsboro is a comprehensive STEM school with a focus on space exploration, bio science, computer science and robotics. Students in kindergarten through grade 5 have specialized lab experiences.
- The Kids Space Center features simulation capabilities for hands-on learning and space flight exploration in one of the most unique elementary school learning environments imaginable.
- Multiple gardens surround our campus allowing students to learn about the germination process and practical steps to maintaining life sustaining fruits and vegetables to help sustain the environment.

# Technology and the Future

• Students are introduced to new technologies and activities designed to build their problem solving, logical thinking, and collaboration skills.



- Space Exploration, Bio- Science, Computer Science and Robotics lessons are provided at each grade level in specialized labs.
- Computer Science 2020 Our students participate in at least 10 hours of computer science learning each school year.

# Student Achievement

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady
  progress monitoring. 77% of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and 73% of K5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **69%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.
