

- 3. Name the bodies of water connected to the Strait of Hormuz. Persian Gulf and Arabian Sea
- 4. Laws that say who can use the water in a region are called "Water Rights"
- 5. What countries are fighting over water rights in the Middle East?
 - a. Turkey, Iraq, and Syria: Tigris and Euphrates
 - b. Jordan, Syria, and Israel: Jordan River
- 6. Define Desalination. What country does desalination affect mostly? Process of removing salt from water, Saudi Arabia
- 7. List the causes and effects of water pollution in the Middle East.
 - a. Oil: polluted water
 - b. Chemicals and fertilizers from farmers: polluted water, can cause salt in soil making soil unfit to farm
 - c. Growth of towns, population, factories: polluted water

- 8. How has the building of dams created problems for countries sharing rivers in Southwest Asia? The building of dams has created problems for countries sharing the same river because the dams block the natural flow of the river, forcing the water to stay in a certain territory and not giving the countries that follow downstream the water that they should be receiving.
