Georgia Inventory of Developing Skills (GKIDS) Mid-Administration Workshop

Purpose

- Provides teachers with ongoing diagnostic information about kindergarten students' developing skills in language arts, math, science, social studies, personal/social development, approaches to learning and motor skills.
- Provides a summary of individual student performance at the end of the kindergarten school year as an indicator of first grade readiness.

What is Assessed?

GPS Content Areas

- ELA
- Math
- Social Studies (optional)
- Science (optional)

Non-Academic Dimensions of Learning

- Personal/Social Development
- Approaches to Learning
- Motor Skills (optional)

GKIDS Top Issues

- Teachers should contact the school coordinator first and then the system test coordinator for assistance with GKIDS.
- Teachers should enter student information into the website in a timely manner.
- Students who transfer from a school/classroom should be released through the GKIDS website so they can be acquired by the new teacher.
- GTID issues should be addressed with the school student database contact and/or Kathy Aspy at the GaDOE.

System Test Coordinator Responsibilities

- Your main role is to manage user accounts for school test coordinators at each school in your system that has Kindergarten teachers.
- During the school year, you will be able to view system and school reports and search for reports on individual students.
- Login names and passwords from 2009-10 are still valid unless requested otherwise by systems.
- New system coordinators should contact GCA to receive a login and password.
- System Test Coordinators are responsible for making certain that schools in the system meet the reporting deadlines.

School Test Coordinator Responsibilities

- Main role is to manage user accounts for the teachers at your school.
- Login names and passwords from 2009-10 are still valid unless requested otherwise by systems.
- During the school year, you will be able to view school and class reports and search for reports on individual students.
- Be prepared to answer questions for the school about navigating the GKIDS Data Entry and Reporting website.
- School Test Coordinators are responsible for making certain that teachers meet the reporting deadlines.

Teacher Responsibilities

- Add your students to the database.
- Enter student data in the required domains.
 - All English Language Arts elements
 - All Math elements
 - All Approaches to Learning elements
 - All Personal/Social Development elements.
- Remove students from your class list if they move to a new school.
- Generate student and class reports throughout the year as needed.

End-of-the-Year Reports

- Teachers may select one of the individual student reports from the GKIDS website to use as the end-of-the-year report.
 - Strand Level
 - Standard Level
 - Element Level
- Class, school, and system reports are also available on the GKIDS website.
- GCA will generate school, system, and state summary reports.

End-of-the-Year Reports

- Information to be entered by **May 13, 2011** to be included in system and state summary reports.
- Teachers are responsible for creating individual student reports.
- **ALL** GKIDS database information will be archived at end of June and not available to recreate 2010-11 school year reports.
- Students who transfer from a school/classroom should be assessed as much as possible prior to end of year.

End-of-the-Year Reports

- Summary reports will include Mathematics, English/Language Arts, Approaches to Learning, and Personal/Social Development.
- Reports will include percentage of students who have met or exceeded the standards in each of the content areas.
- Summary reports will only include information that has been entered into reporting tool by classroom teachers.
- Datafile of all district information will be provided to System Test Coordinator.
