ELA Section #1- 45-65 minutes with max of 90

ELA Section #2/3-40-60 minutes per section with max of 80 per section

Math Section #1/2- 30-50 minutes per section with max of 65 per section

Science #1/2- (5<sup>th</sup> grade only) 20-30 minutes per section with max of 40 per session

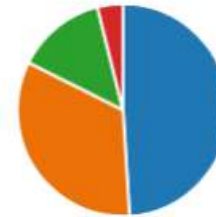
