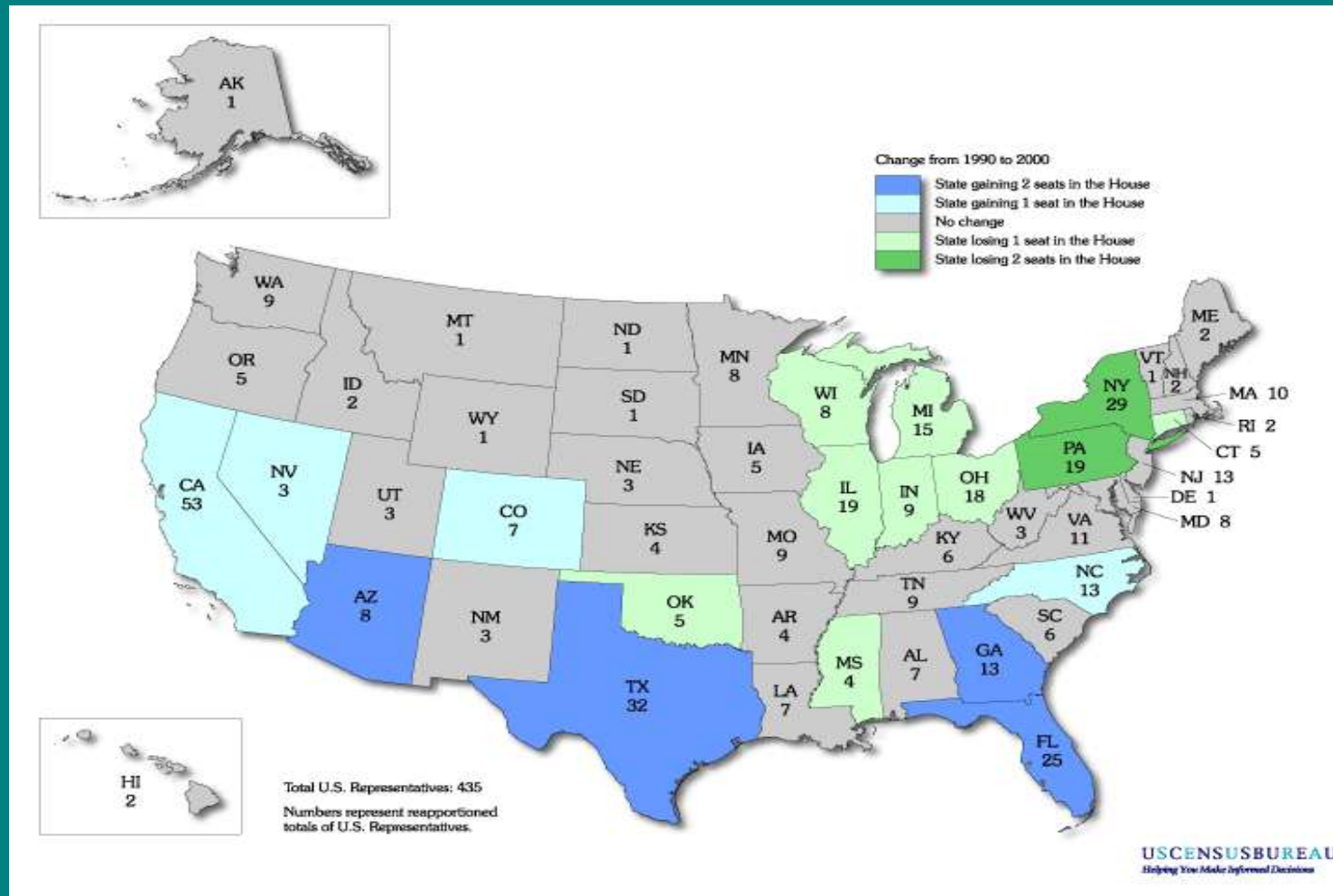
Congress

Supreme Court



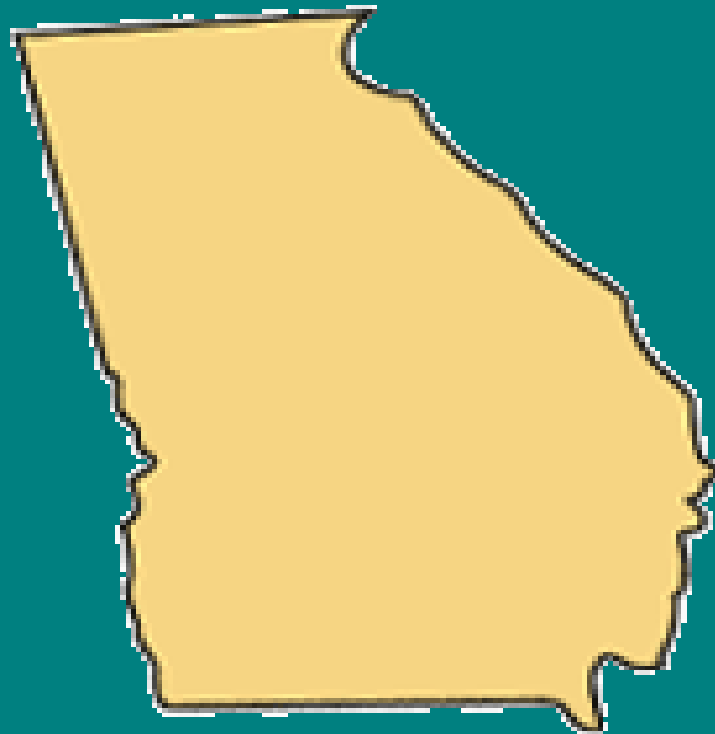

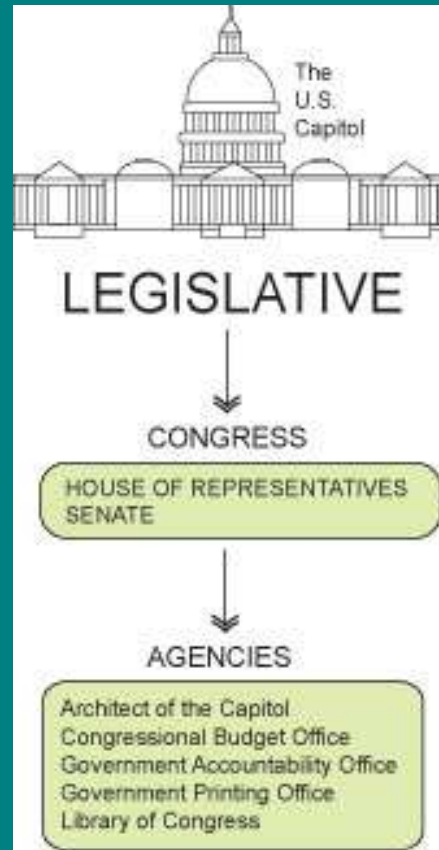

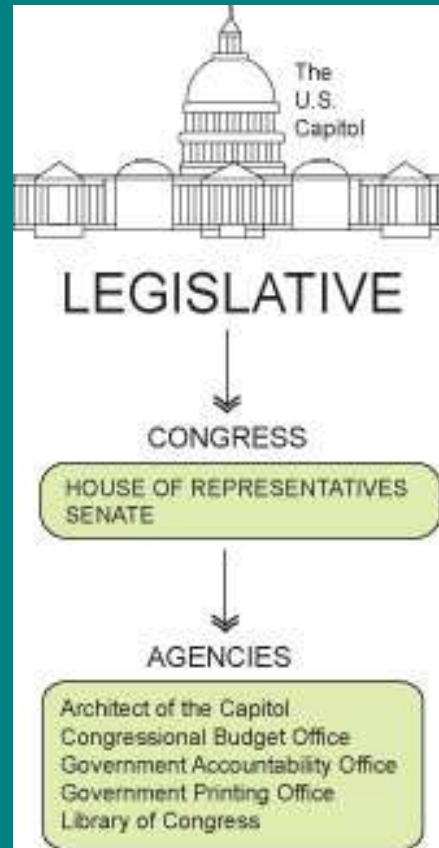
