Grade 10 FSA ELA Graduation Requirements

Scoring a Level 3 or higher on the Grade 10 FSA ELA, or earning a comparative/concordant score, is a graduation requirement. <u>In order to meet the Grade 10 FSA ELA graduation requirement, you must meet one of the following criteria:</u>

Earn a Level 3 or higher (SS 350+) on the Grade 10 FSA ELA, which is administered twice a year, fall and spring. The FSA ELA consists of three sessions: Writing and two Reading sessions, all three must be completed in order to earn a score.

2020-2021 Grade 10 FSA ELA Testing Dates:

September 14-December 18, 2020 February 22-March 12, 2021

Earn a 480+ on the EBRW section of the SAT **or** an average of 18+ on the English and Reading sections of the ACT. These tests can be attempted as many times as needed during any school year.
