Previous School:

Students who score a mid to high 3, or a 4 or 5 on the spring FSA will be placed in accelerated (advanced) math. Parents, if you do not wish for your child to be placed in an accelerated (advanced) math class, it is your responsibility to email your child's guidance counselor BEFORE May 6, 2022. After that date, Math placement will be very difficult to change.

*High School Credit

No High School credit courses can be dropped after the first quarter. This includes Algebra 1 Honors, Geometry, Digital Information Technology, and Spanish 1. Students taking Algebra 1 Honors must take Geometry in 8th grade and 4 additional math credits in High School. Please review the math progression plan on the back of the parent letter.

iSeries Courses

The Student Progression Plan requires iJourney (semester course) and either iConnect (semester course) or iChallenge (semester or year long course).

Rock Lake Middle School presents the **Raider Triple Crown Challenge**: Over the course of your middle school career, take **iJourney**, **iConnect** <u>and</u> **iChallenge** and

- Earn an overall A, B, or C grade for each course
- Take certification exams in all three courses.
- Pass at least one certification exam in each course (3 certifications) to earn the *Crown* level
- Pass 4 certifications to earn the Crown with Garnet level
- Pass 5 certifications to earn the *Crown with Sapphire* level

Meeting the **Raider Triple Crown Challenge** will earn distinction at the eighth grade awards assembly and honor on the future Raider Triple Crown Challenge Wall of Fame.
