### Grade Classification

High school graduation requirements – Students will follow the requirements that were in place when they entered their high school. A **9<sup>th</sup> grade** student has been promoted or assigned from 8<sup>th</sup> grade. A **10<sup>th</sup> grade** student earned 6 credits. An **11<sup>th</sup> grade** student earned 12 credits. A **12<sup>th</sup> grade** student earned 19 credits

### Tips about your schedule

Foreign language- We recommend two years of the same language to meet requirements for colleges/universities but it is not required for graduation.

Math credits earned in middle school do not count towards the 4 credits needed for graduation.

Virtual class requirement can be satisfied with any complete class through SCVS or FLVS.

Community Service is recommended for FL Bright Futures Scholarship but not required for graduation.
