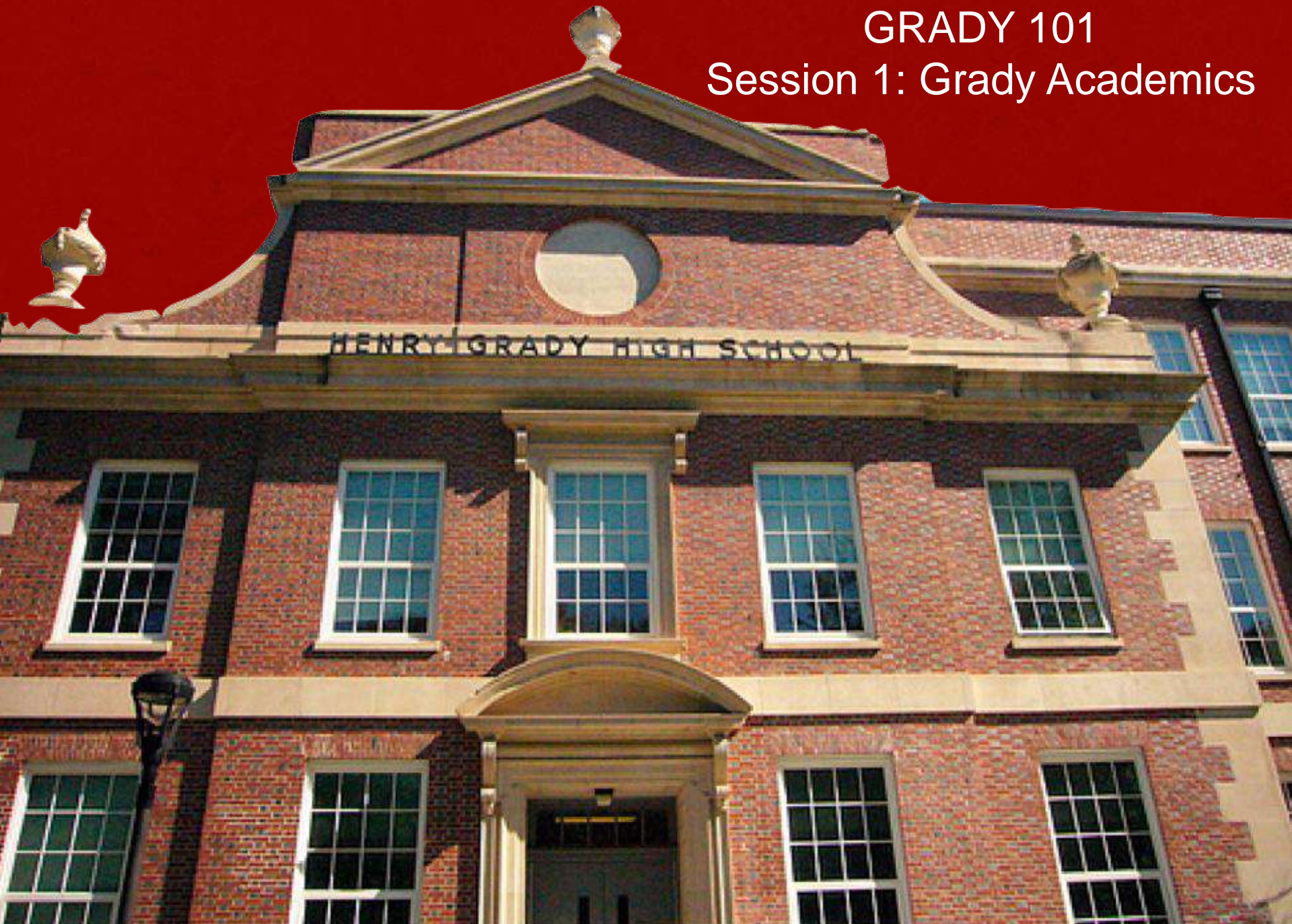

ATLANTA PUBLIC SCHOOLS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Satisfy attendance requirements (no more than 10 unexcused absences)
- Successfully complete required high school coursework
- Complete 75 hours of community service
- Pass the Writing part of the Georgia High School Graduation Test (GHS GT)

ATLANTA PUBLIC SCHOOLS REQUIRED COURSEWORK

Core Credits

English/Language Arts: 4 Units

- *1 unit Ninth Grade Literature/Composition*
- *1 unit American Literature/Composition*
- *2 units English/Language Arts Core (may include AP/IB courses)*

Math: 4 Units

- *1 unit CCGPS Coordinate Algebra*
- *1 unit CCGPS Analytic Geometry*
- *1 unit CCGPS Advanced Algebra*
- *1 additional unit Mathematics Core (may include AP/IB courses)*

Science: 4 Units

- *1 unit Biology 1*
- *1 unit Physical Science or Physics 1*
- *1 unit Chemistry 1, Earth Systems, Environmental Science or an AP/IB course*
- *1 unit Science Core (may include AP/IB courses)*

ATLANTA PUBLIC SCHOOLS REQUIRED COURSEWORK CONTINUED...

Social Studies: 3.5 Units

- *½ unit World Geography*
- *½ unit American Government/Civics*
- *½ unit Economics/Business/Free Enterprise*
- *1 unit United States History*
- *1 unit World History*

Foreign Language: 2 Units

- *2 units of the same modern language (French, Spanish, or Latin)*

Electives Units: 6.5 Units

- *1 unit Fine Arts or Career/Technology*
- *1.5 units Health & Physical Education*
- *3.5 units Thematic Pathways*
- *½ Community Service*

24 Total Units Required to Graduate

ACADEMIES

- **Four:** Biomedical Science & Engineering, Business & Entrepreneurship, Communications & Journalism, Law & Leadership
- Next year, every Grady student will be in an academy
- Placement is based solely upon student interest
- Academy selection process typically happens in the spring; more information will be provided when available.
- The academies determine the theme-based electives **ONLY**. All Grady students follow the same academic course of study and have equal access to AP classes.
