Guide for Adjusting Test Settings in TIDE for Accommodations and Supports

Overview

This guide will assist you with setting accommodations for digital test takers in the Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE). It provides an overview of accommodations and the digital test settings and tools that are available in the Cambium Assessment Inc. (CAI) Test Delivery System. Contents of this guide are divided into tables listing common Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) accommodations and instructions for setting or enabling each feature for students' tests. Additional instructions are also provided at digitaltesting.collegeboard.org/accommodations.

About TIDE: View/Edit Test Settings

TIDE's View/Edit screen (shown below) for managing student test settings is divided into multiple sections or categories. Similarly, the tables of this document are divided into the same categories and include instructions for modifying the category in alignment with each student's accommodations or supports. The categories of test settings include:

- Section A: State or College Board Approved Accommodations, page 5
- Section B: Test Time and Breaks, page 7
- Section C: Reading/Seeing Text, page 11
- Section D: Four-Function Calculator, page 16

How to use this guide

Refer to this guide when you are ready to modify student test settings in TIDE for students with accommodations. Even if you plan to import a file into TIDE to set accommodations, refer to this guide first to ensure that you have set the attributes for each student and that you have selected the correct accommodations in your spreadsheet.

For each student, begin with **Section A: State or College Board Approved Accommodations** in TIDE. Then, find the students' accommodation in the first column of **Section A** on page 5 and modify the attributes in TIDE as described in the table row. If students are approved for additional accommodations, you will need to continue to Section B: Test Time and Breaks, page 7; Section C: Reading/Seeing Text on page 11; and/or Section D: Four-Function Calculator on page 16. You will notice that some settings that do not require a change and should remain at their defaulted selection.

Section A: State or College Board Approved Accommodations (Attributes)

When configuring test settings in TIDE, you must also select the appropriate attributes for **Accommodations, English Learner (EL) Supports** and **Non-Embedded Accommodations**, for each student.

NOTE: *If you will be using a file upload to modify student test settings in bulk, you must manually modify the attributes for each student **before** the upload can be processed. TIDE applies validation rules which will not allow you to save any test settings until attributes are selected for each student.*

Follow the instructions in the columns of Section A on page 5 to make a selection from the **Accommodations** drop-down:

- Select **College Board Accommodations** if the accommodations have been approved by College Board's SSD program.
- Select **State-Allowed Accommodations** if your school is part of a state contract and the accommodations are state allowed, not College Board approved.*
- For **PSAT 8/9**: Make no selection if the student is taking the PSAT 8/9 and their accommodations aren't approved by College Board or the state.

For English Learner (EL) Supports:

- Select **Yes for English Learner (EL) Supports** only if the student will be using time and one-half (+50%) for English learners.
- Select **No** (the default option) for students who are only using translated test directions or word-to-word dictionaries.

For Non-Embedded Accommodations:

- Select **Yes** if the student is only testing with accommodations that are administered outside of the platform, e.g., small test setting, preferred seating, etc.

Section B: Test Time and Breaks

In Test Time and Breaks, enable time accommodations for students who are approved for extended time, extra or extended breaks, or breaks as needed. This will enable the clock in the secure browser to reflect their time accommodation; and it will enable the proctor's clock to pause for scripted mid-section breaks.

Test sections in TIDE are displayed in a horizontal list, 0-5. That is:

0. Questionnaire
1. Reading Test
2. Writing and Language Test
3. Math Test — No Calculator
4. Math Test — Calculator
5. Essay (SAT Only)

Refer to Section B on page 7 to find the approved timing accommodation and follow the instructions for selecting the accommodation for each test section it applies to. You will also find the script number that should be used on test day.

For example, a student who is approved for the extended time accommodation of **Double Time – Reading** should be assigned “Double Time (+100%)” on test sections 1-5. On test day, the proctor must read from Script 3 or Script 5 (on SAT with Essay). No timing selection is needed for the Questionnaire because it is not a timed section.

NOTE: *If a student is approved for only **breaks** (extra, extended, or as needed), set TIDE for “Extra/Extended Breaks – Standard Time.” This setting will allow the proctor to pause the student's test as instructed in the script or as deemed appropriate for the student.*

* State Allowed Accommodations result in scores that are not reportable to colleges or for scholarship programs. They should be used only in rare instances. Any student with the Accommodation Type as “State Allowed Accommodation” in TIDE will receive scores; however, they cannot be used for admissions or scholarship purposes.

Section C: Reading/Seeing Text

The Reading/Seeing Text category includes test settings and features that may be enabled for students with various visual accommodation needs. This includes Text-to-Speech, Assistive Technology, Zoom, Font Size, Color Contrast, Mouse Pointer, Streamline Mode and Permissive Mode. In many cases, these features are digital alternatives to the accommodations as you know them. For example, Pre-Recorded Audio/MP3 Streaming is not compatible with the Digital SAT Suite, however, Text-to-Speech is the alternative feature for digital test takers. Using this document, you will find Pre-Recorded Audio/MP3 Streaming in the Accommodation Name column, and a selection of “TTS (Read Text Only) or TTS (Read Text and Graphics)” in the column labeled Text-to-Speech/Assistive Technology.

Locate the student’s approved accommodation and follow the guidance in Section C on page 11 to enable the features described below:

- **Text-to-Speech (TTS)** allows the test to be read aloud. Select read text only or read text and graphics based on student’s documented need.
 - ◆ **Read Text Only** provides an alternative short description or textual equivalent for an image. This enables the native speech synthesizer to read the text on the screen and the short image description. It is intended for students who do not require a detailed description of images. **Students using this accommodation will test with Time and One-half (+50%), please also see Test Time and Breaks on page 7 to adjust the student’s test time.**
 - ◆ **Read Text and Graphics** provides an alternative long description for an image, graphic, chart, etc. In addition to reading the text on the screen, the native speech synthesizer reads a detailed description of all images, graphics, charts, etc. It is intended for students who require a detailed description in order to process information. **Students using this accommodation will test with Double Time (+100%) , please also see Test Time and Breaks on page 7 to adjust the student’s test time.**
- **Assistive Technology (AT)** enables the use of AT software and hardware (e.g., screen readers, refreshable braille devices, etc.).
- **Zoom/Font Size** sets font size for presentation of test content.
- **Color Contrast** displays the test with a different background or font color.
- **Mouse Pointer** adjusts the mouse/cursor to match color and size preferences.
- **Streamline Mode** presents questions sequentially without a split screen.
- **Permissive Mode** allows students with AT software and/or hardware to integrate with the secure browser.

Section D: Four-Function Calculator

Enabling **Yes** in this category allows students to use the basic four-function embedded calculator on the Math Test – No Calculator section.

Multiple Accommodations

If a student is approved for multiple accommodations, enable the features by combining instructions across rows. For example, if a student is approved for Reading: Time and one-half (+50%), and Four-Function Calculator, refer to Section B: Test Time and Breaks on page 7, and Section D: Four Function Calculator on page 16.

As a result, in TIDE you will select **Time and One-Half (+50%)** on test sections 1 through 5 and toggle **YES** on **Four-Function Calculator**.
