



## **GPA & Grade Requirements**

- There are no GPA or grade requirements to apply for the Academy of Health Careers. However, please keep in mind that students taking high school level courses in middle school counting towards a graduation requirement (i.e., Alg 1, Biology, world language, etc.), will need to retake any courses in which a D or F is earned, if admitted into the program.
- In the Academy of Health Careers at Seminole HS, students must meet certain grade and GPA requirements from semester to semester to remain in the program.
  - Students must maintain a minimum weighted GPA of a 2.5. Grade point averages are checked by counselors at the beginning of the school year during credit checks, after the end of the first semester, and at the end of the year when second semester grades are released. Students who do not meet GPA requirements at the beginning of the year or at the end of the first semester, are placed on academic probation and must have a GPA of a 2.5 at the end of the year if they wish to remain in the program. Students who do not have a GPA of a 2.5 at the end of the year are in jeopardy of being dismissed from the Academy.
  - Students must earn a grade of C or better for each semester of their Health Science course. Students who earn a D or F in any semester of a Health Science course will be dismissed from the program at the end of the school year as these courses are not offered in summer school or virtual school.
  - Students must earn a C or better in all semesters of academic core courses (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language). Students that earn a D or F in a semester of an academic core course will be placed on academic probation and will have to retake the course in summer school or through virtual school. A letter will be mailed home to the mailing address on file (in Skyward) outlining the deadline for completion of courses. It is the parent's/student's responsibility to pick up the student's report card at the end of the year and make sure the address on file is correct. Students who do not retake courses by their assigned deadline will be in jeopardy from being dismissed from the Academy.
