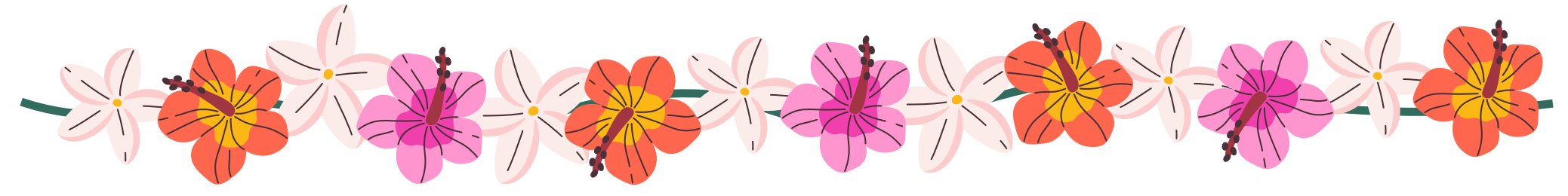

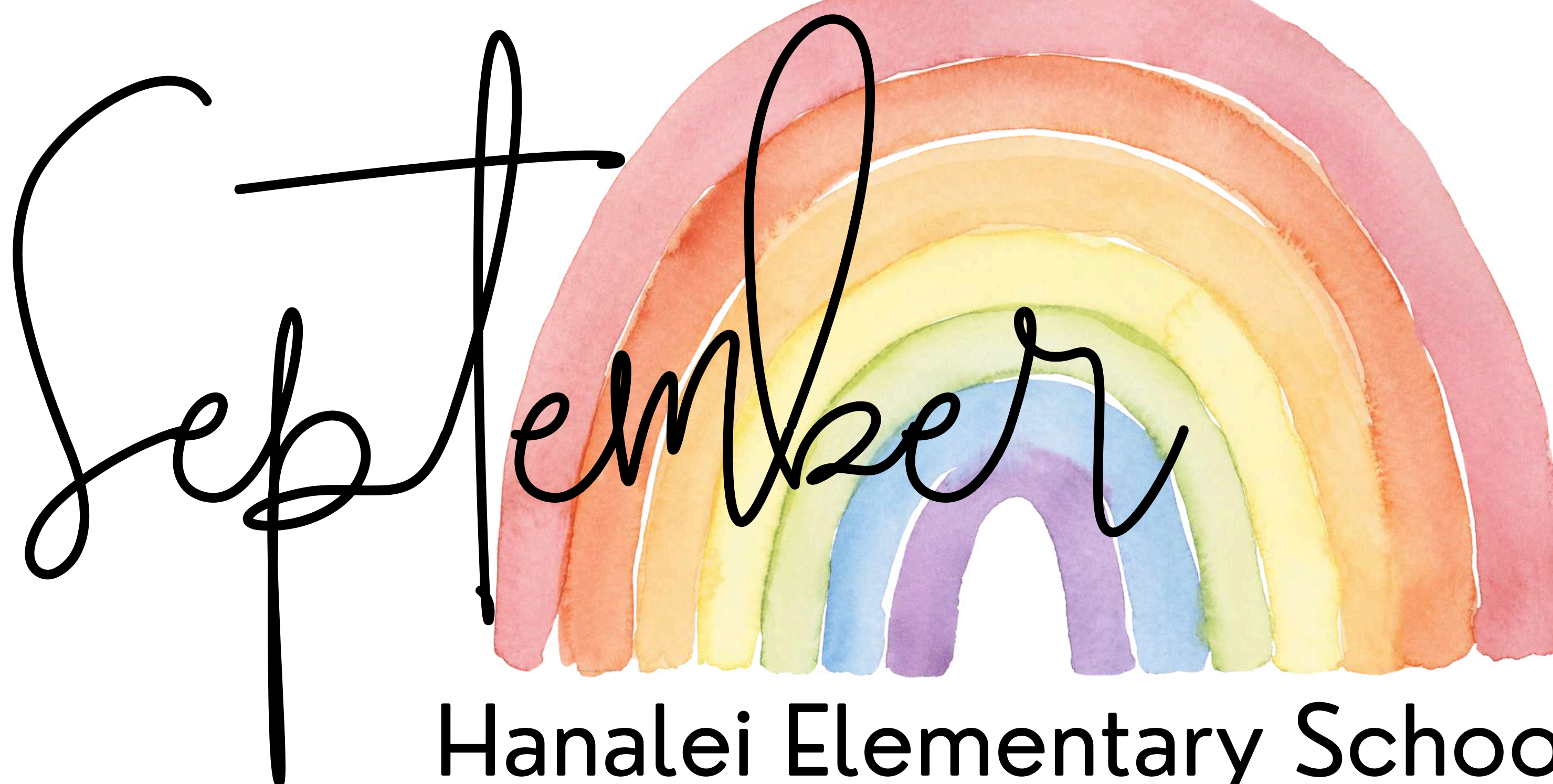

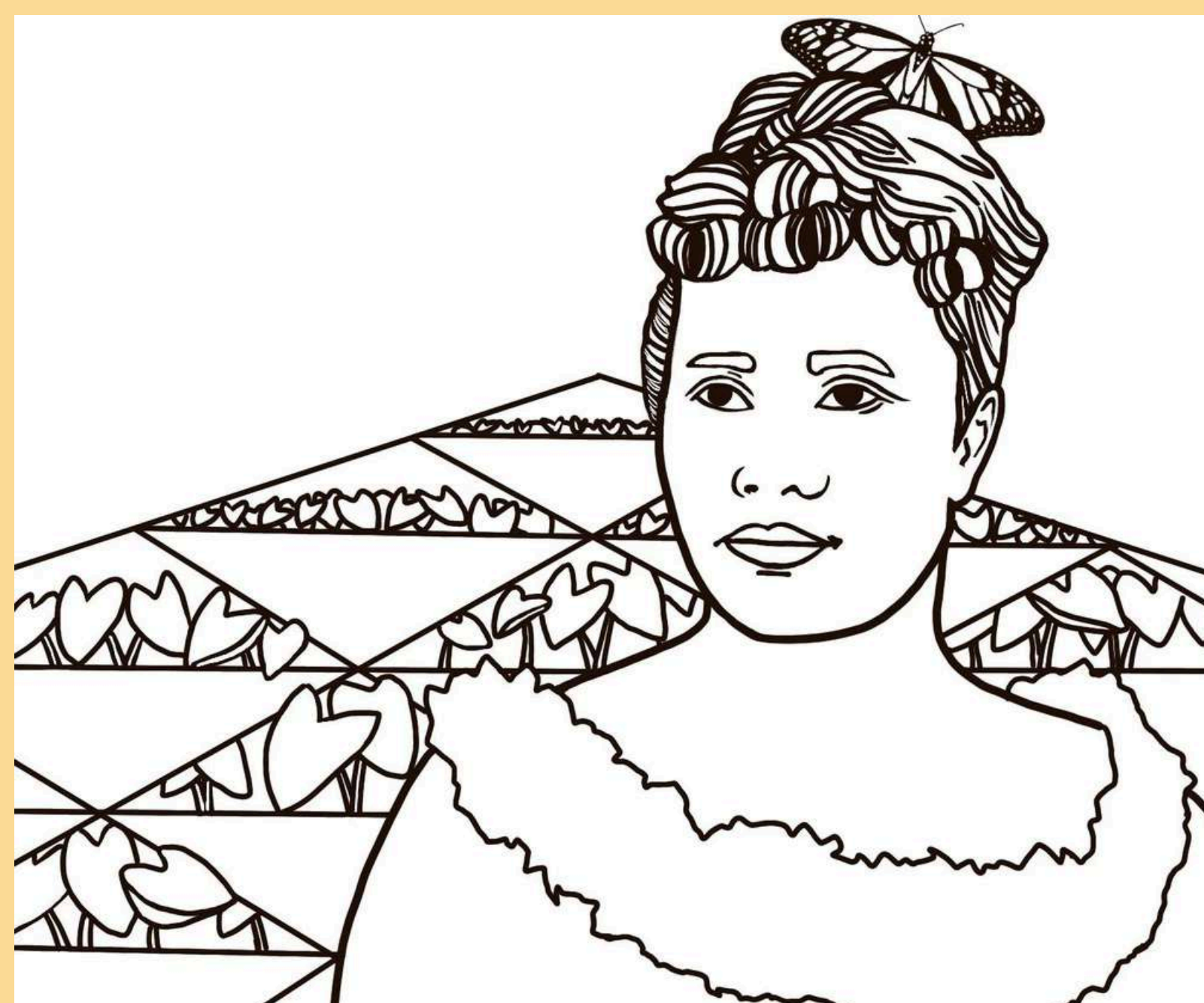

Queen Lili'uokalani

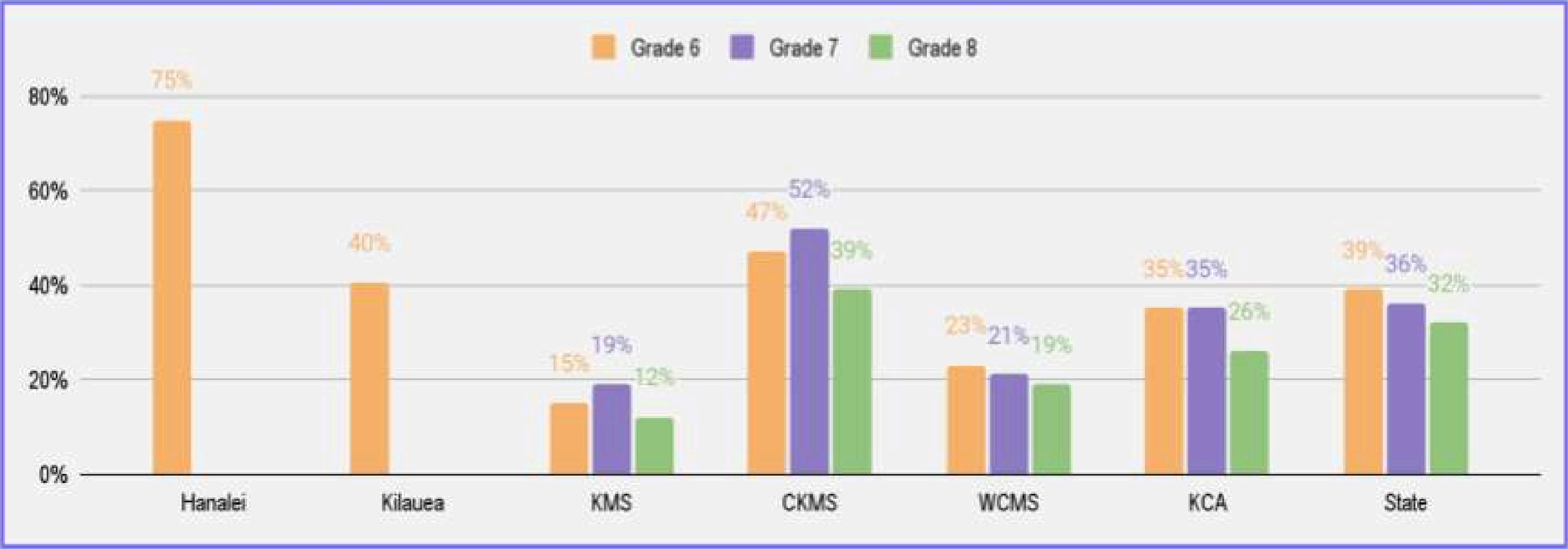
The SBA offers an objective measurement of learning and a reliable means for comparing student achievement and growth.

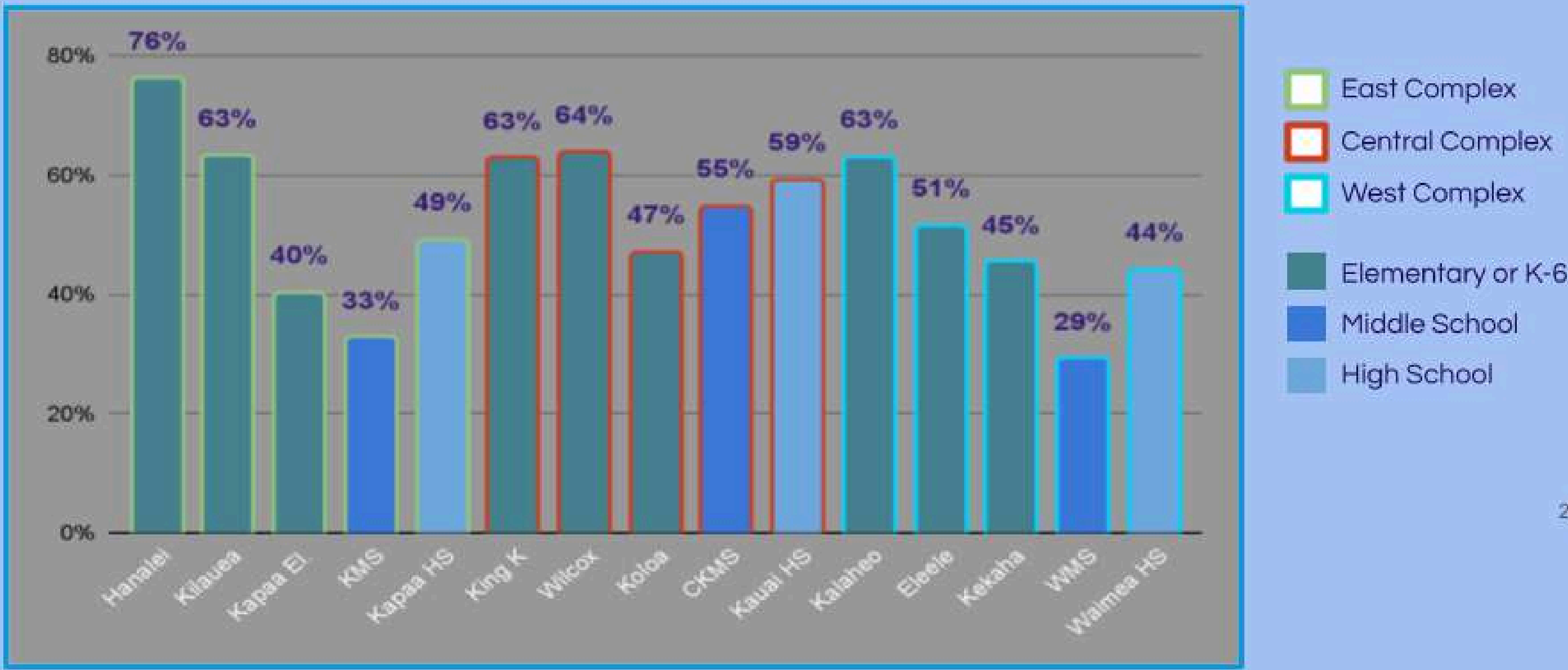

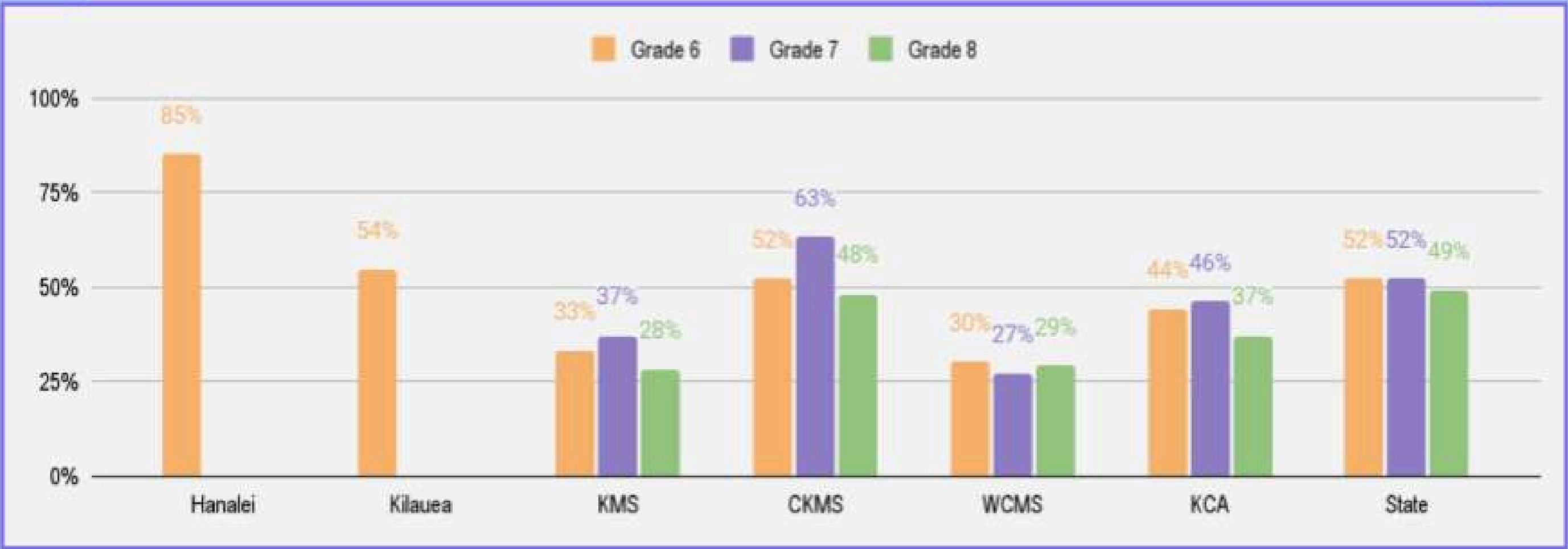
KCA SBA MATH PROFICIENCY 2023-24

With the addition of hiring a Library Assistant, I'll have more time to dedicate to supporting the social and emotional needs of our students. Similar to previous years, as the School Counselor I will be providing the following counseling services:

1. Emotional Support: I am available to listen and help students work through any feelings or challenges they may be experiencing. Whether it's a concern about school or a personal issue, the counselor provides a safe and supportive space for students to express themselves.
2. Social Skills Development: Helping children build positive relationships is a key focus. I will be facilitating activities and lessons that teach important social skills, such as growth mindset, empathy, and conflict resolution.
3. Conflict Resolution: I often assist students in resolving conflicts and understanding different perspectives, which contributes to a more harmonious school environment.
4. Parent and Teacher Collaboration: I often work with parents and teachers to provide a well-rounded support system for each student. This collaborative approach ensures that everyone involved in a child's education is working together for their success.
5. Preventive Programs: Every year I facilitate small groups on various topics, such as stress management, coping skills, goal setting and friendship skills to promote a positive and healthy school climate.
