REMINDER OF THE GOALS:

- **1. IN ORDER TO FORM A MORE PERFECT UNION**
 - To unite the states more effectively and to cooperate so they can operate as a single nation, for the good of all.
- **2. ESTABLISH JUSTICE**
 - To create a system of fair laws and courts and make certain that all citizens are treated equally.
- **3. INSURE DOMESTIC TRANQUILITY**
 - To maintain *peace* and *order*, keeping citizens and property *safe* from harm.
- **4. PROVIDE FOR THE COMMON DEFENSE**
 - To be ready militarily to protect the country and it's citizens from outside attack.
- **5. PROMOTE THE GENERAL WELFARE**
 - To help people live healthy, happy, and prosperous lives
- **6. SECURE THE BLESSINGS TO OURSELVES AND OUR POSTERITY**
 - To guarantee the freedom and basic rights of all Americans, including future generations ("posterity").

- 1. U.S. troops are sent to the nearby island of Haiti to help maintain order when the Hatian government is overthrown.
- 2. State police were sent into Ferguson, Missouri to settle unrest between upset citizens and local police after the shooting death of Michael Brown.
- 3. U.S troops prepare for a raid on an Iraqi town where terrorists are believed to be operating and plotting another attack against the United States.
- 4. The Department of Agriculture puts out a new food pyramid which helps people plan a healthy diet.
- 5. The Treasury Department issues paper money and mints coins for the entire country

- 6. The Department of Energy provides funding for research on wind energy so that it may help us reduce our reliance on oil.
- 7. The Department of Transportation maintains the nation's interstate highway system. Repairing highways that connect the various states in the country.
- 8. The Veterans Administration operates hospitals where people who have served in the military can receive health care services.
- 9. The Department of Labor gives \$1.9 million to the Hotel and Restaurant Employees Union to train newly arriving legal immigrants for hospitality industry jobs in Las Vegas, Nevada and Atlantic City, New Jersey.
- 10. The Food and Drug administration requires drug companies to do multiple tests on new drugs before they can be prescribed by doctors and sold in the United States.

- 15. The national Park Services announces the re-opening of the Statue of Liberty. A statue that welcomes immigrants into our country who yearn for a better life.

- 16. An immigration judge rejects the asylum application of a 25 year old Guatemalan gang member who claims he will be murdered if he returns home.

- 17. The National Institute on Aging funds a long term study on how long Alzheimer's patients live after they are diagnosed with the disease.

- 18. The United States maintains diplomatic relations with about 180 countries around the world.

- 19. The Bureau of Land Management opens certain government-owned lands to mining.
