## **Changes to December 1 Child Count Reporting**

**Beginning with the 2015-16 school year, all students receiving special education and related services on December 1, 2015 must be reported with the March 4, 2016 approval transmission.**

ISBE will provide a report listing all students that are identified as duplicates by early February 2016. These duplicates must be resolved before the March 4<sup>th</sup> transmission. After the March 4<sup>th</sup> transmission is received and processed by ISBE, reports listing your official child count number will be sent to each district. There will be a short validation period to confirm that this number is correct, however, March 21, 2016 will be the deadline for completing the validation period. The December 1, 2015 child count reported to OSEP on April 6<sup>th</sup> will constitute the state's official 2015-16 special education count.

Districts should continue to report additions and changes for students with disabilities on subsequent approval transmissions for the 2015-16 school year through June 30<sup>th</sup>, however, no changes will be made to the official December 1 child count.
