





HCCMS Student-athletes are chosen because they demonstrate talent and a commitment to their sport of choice. This commitment begins as they decide which sport is best suited for their talents. As students decide to try out, we ask that you adhere to the sign-up procedures and paperwork completion. We will publish the sign-up dates and physical due dates on our website and make daily announcements. All potential athletes are to complete the following steps in order to participate:

- 1. Sign up on our school website under the "Sports" tab
- 2. Complete the physical, medical consent, concussion and cardiac forms and submit those forms by the published due date.
- 3. Come to tryouts/conditioning on time and ready to participate

We have a responsibility to make sure that our athletes are eligible according to the Muscogee County Athletic Department rules/regulations. This takes some time as we are looking to check grades and submission of paperwork. Those who miss the deadline for sign up and paperwork submission will be delayed by one day for tryouts/conditioning. This will provide our team with adequate time to clear the student for safety and eligibility. Be sure to adhere to the coaching staff's requirements. Some do require that students attend all days of tryouts before being considered for the team.
