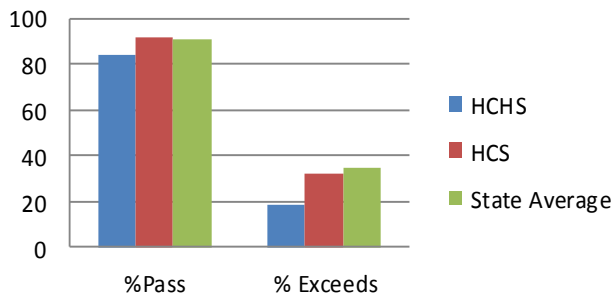
STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Strategic Goal: 10th Grade Students will be On-Track for Graduation

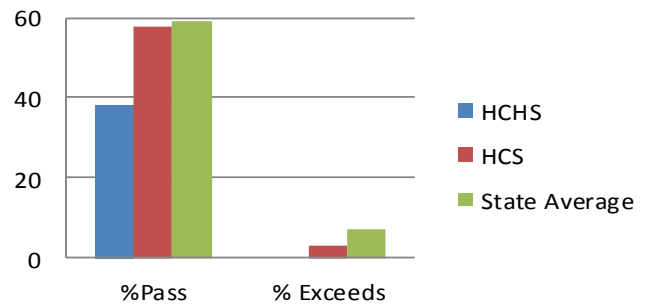
High school graduation is a critical achievement for every student. Non-graduates tend to have much lower earning potential and far higher unemployment rates than high school graduates. Graduation rates are significantly higher among students who are on-track for graduation at the end of their 9th and 10th grade years. Students who are off-track at the end of the 10th grade are more likely to become disengaged from school and can find it difficult to get back on track to graduate within four years.

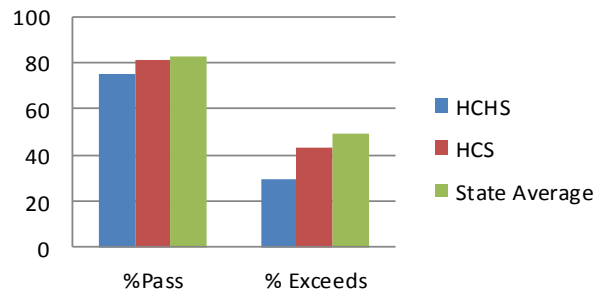
American Literature EOCT

Today, only 20% of jobs are considered unskilled, while 50% are identified as middle skill and 30% are recognized as high skill jobs. Postsecondary education and training has become a necessity for our students, and we must ensure they graduate high school with the skills for college and career success.
