### J.W. MITCHELL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT AGREEMENT

\*\*\*ONLY DONE IF STUDENT/GUEST IS CURRENT STUDENT AT JWMHS\*\*\*

The following document represents an agreement between you, a JWMHS student, and J.W. Mitchell High School. It is your responsibility to resolve any and all questions concerning any of the terms and conditions listed in this agreement prior to the date of the Homecoming. If you and/or your guest fail to meet any of the terms or conditions listed in this agreement you understand that you and/or your guest will be required to leave the event and that no refund of the ticket price will be issued. In consideration of being sold a ticket and being granted admission to J.W. Mitchell High School's Homecoming you agree to the following terms and conditions:

#### NO RE-ENTRY and STUDENT BEHAVIOR

There will be no re-entry to Homecoming at JWMHS. Once you and/or your guest enter the facility at JWMHS and relinquish your ticket(s) to the event, you and/or your guest are prohibited from leaving and re-entering the facility. JWMHS reserves the right per the Student Code of Conduct and statute, upon reasonable suspicion to search all cars, party busses, and limos, as well as purses and other belongings. This dance is a tobacco free, drug free, and alcohol free activity. The use of tobacco products, drugs, and alcohol is NOT permitted. We STRONGLY RECOMMEND NOT employing limousines or party buses.

#### IDENTIFICATION

You must provide one of the following in order to gain admittance to the Homecoming: a school ID, a government issued ID, a passport, or a driver license. We recommend that you either take a picture of your ID and have it on your phone or that you bring a paper copy of your ID. There will be no exceptions whatsoever, even if school personnel at the event recognize you and/or your guest.

#### DRESS CODE

The following dress code is applicable to all students and guests who wish to enter the Homecoming. *All guests must comply with all school and Code of Conduct requirements.* If you have questions concerning your dress, it is your responsibility to seek prior approval for administration. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before that evening. Any student or guest that fails to meet any of the following conditions will be denied entry to the event:

- **Dress Code for Young Men:** Dress pants, dress shirt and dress shoes. A tie and jacket is strongly recommended. All pants must be securely worn around the waist. No "polo" style shirts will be allowed. Athletics shoes/sneakers (i.e. Nikes, Adidas, etc.) or workboots will not be permitted. The principal's/designee's decision is *FINAL*.
- **Dress Code for Young Women:** Must wear a dress, pant suit or gown that is in good taste. The outfit may not be made of see-through material. Strapless dresses are allowed; however, no open styles, which show the entire back or stomach areas, are permitted. The back must completely be covered below the bottom of the young woman's shoulder blades. Two-piece dresses will be allowed; however, please make sure that the front necklines shall not be lower than a line formed between the right and left armpit and the space between the two pieces must not exceed three inches. This guideline governs cleavage and the principal's/designee's decision is *FINAL*. The dress length and all slits cannot exceed more than four inches above the knee.
- **Dress Code for Both Young Men and Young Women:** Students dressed inappropriately will be turned away at the door. Students will not be admitted wearing cargo pants, sneakers, jeans/denim, khakis, Dickies (or other casual pants), t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products. Adjustments made at the door or during the dance (including pinning, the addition of a jacket, the addition of a body suit, etc.) will not be accepted as solutions for violations of the dress code. The principal's/designee's decision is *FINAL*.

#### DANCE FLOOR BEHAVIOR

Sexually suggestive dancing is not appropriate and will not be tolerated. This includes grinding, grind trains, bending over, straddling legs, lap dancing, etc. Inappropriate touching is also prohibited. If these expectations are not followed, the lights will be turned on in the gymnasium. If students continue to not follow expectations, they will be asked to leave without refund. Verbal warnings will be given via the DJ and the music changed as a collective warning for everyone. Appropriate dancing includes, hands on the waist or shoulders only, both feet on the floor, and respectful public displays of affection.

#### END OF DANCE PROCEDURES

Students are not allowed to re-enter the dance upon leaving. Once you have left the dance, you CANNOT, under any circumstances re-enter. Students must vacate the premises within 30 minutes of the dance ending.
