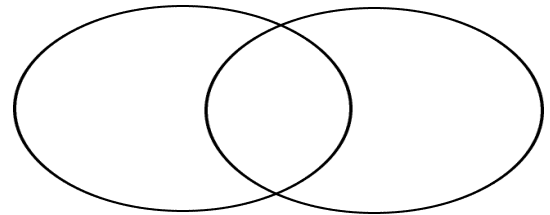
THURSDAY
