Standard courses are weighted on a 4.0 scale, indicated with a 0 in the Honors column

Honors courses are weighted on a 4.5 scale, indicated with a 1 in the Honors column

Dual Enrollment & AP courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale, indicated with a 2 in the Honors column

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Students should circle the following:

- Unweighted GPA (must be 2.0 or above to graduate; 3.0 or above for dual enrollment)
- FSA ELA 10 (taken in 10th grade, students must earn level 3 or above for graduation)
- Algebra 1 EOC (taken while student is enrolled in Algebra 1, must earn level 3 or above for graduation). Biology, Geometry, Algebra 1 and US History EOC's will count 30% towards students' final grade.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Grades for yearlong courses with state EOC's will not post until the end of the year (Algebra, Geometry, Biology, and US History)

GPA and credits will update twice a year – in January after semester 1 grades post and June/July after semester 2 grades and EOC scores post.

Senior class rank (Valedictorian & Salutatorian inclusive) shall be based on a 5.0 weighted grade point average on all courses taken for high school credit. Calculations of GPAs for valedictorian and salutatorian shall be made at the conclusion of the seventh semester.

When students earn a final grade of D or F on their high school transcript, students have the option of taking the same course again virtually (FLVS or SJVS) for grade forgiveness, if that course is available. When a student earns a C or better in the 2nd attempt, the previous D or F will not be calculated in the GPA. However, all courses and grades must be included on the students transcript.

SOMETHING WRONG WITH YOUR CREDIT DETAIL REPORT?

If a course is **MISSING** from your credit detail report, write down the following and give it back to the school counselor:

- When you took the course (7th grade? 8th grade?)
 - Where you took the course (LPA, Swiss, FLVS, SJVS, etc)
 - What course is missing (Algebra 1, HOPE, etc)
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- If something is **WRONG** with your credit detail report, write down (or circle) what is wrong and give it back to the school counselor
