



1. Apply Online

Click the Apply Now button at www.laniertech.edu



2. Submit Residency Documentation

Students may submit a copy of their driver's license or state ID via the upload feature in the application portal or email to admissions@laniertech.edu.

Non-citizen students must also submit a copy of their permanent resident card or employment authorization card.



3. Request Official High School Transcript

The final high school transcript will need to be sent to the Admissions Office.

- If you are completing your admissions file prior to high school graduation, we will need
 the Verification of Anticipated High School Diploma form completed by your high
 school counselor in addition to your in-progress transcript.
- The Technical College System of Georgia does not recognize Certificate of Attendance,
 Certificate of Performance or Special Education Diplomas

If the student previously attended a college other than Lanier Technical College for Dual Enrollment, request an official transcript be sent from all colleges attended.



4. Provide Satisfactory Placement or Take the Placement Exam (ACCUPLACER®)

Lanier Technical College accepts:

- SAT/PSAT scores (school code: 7289)
- ACT/Pre-ACT scores (school code: 7096)
- High School GPA (2.00 for Cert/Dip and 2.60 for Degree Programs)
- High school GPA of 2.0 for approved Entry Level Workforce Certificates.
- ACCUPLACER scores If a student needs to take the ACCUPLACER at Lanier Technical College, please contact the nearest campus location to schedule.
