



Frequently Asked Questions High School Summer Academy Program



1. Which schools are eligible to participate in the Summer Academy?

All Atlanta Public High Schools are eligible to participate in the Summer Academy.

2. Which students from these schools are eligible to participate in the High School Summer Academy program?

Current 9th – 12th grade students who are in need of credit recovery are eligible for Summer Academy. Any student needing to retake GHSGT or EOCT in order to graduate from high school is eligible for Summer Academy.



3. What are the dates of the High School Summer Academy?

High School Summer Academy will run from June 4 – July 16, 2014.

4. What are the hours for Summer Academy?

Summer Academy hours for 9th – 12th grade are from 7:30 AM – 12:30 PM.

5. What is the focus of the Summer Academy?

The Summer Academy is designed to provide students with the opportunity for credit recovery.



6. Will there be an EOCT/GHSGT at the conclusion of Summer Academy?

- ♦ EOCT testing for Summer Academy June 30 – July 11, 2014.
- ♦ GHSGT testing July 14 – July 18, 2014.

7. What are the sites for Summer Academy?

The sites for High School Summer Academy are:

- ♦ Therrell High School (West Region)
- ♦ Grady High School (East Region)
- ♦ Carver High School (South Region)
- ♦ Coretta Scott King High School (North Region)
- ♦ GHSGT Tutorial (Alonzo Crim Open Campus)



8. What is the cost to attend Summer Academy?

The Summer Academy is free to participants.

9. What are the expectations for students during Summer Academy?

Students are expected to maintain consistent attendance, positive behavior, and a commitment to learning during the Summer Academy. Students who have two or more absences, inappropriate behavior, or are not engaged in learning will be withdrawn from the program. Note three or more tardies account to an absence.



10. Will transportation be provided to the Summer Academy school sites?

Transportation is NOT provided for the 9th – 12th Grade Summer Academy program.

11. Will breakfast and lunch be served at Summer Academy?

Breakfast and lunch will be provided for the 9th – 12th Grade Summer Academy program.
