### What is ACCESS?

It is a test to determine the English proficiency level for all English Learners (ELs)

It helps the teachers help the students with English.



Listening	Process, understand, interpret and evaluate spoken language in a variety of situations
Reading	Process, understand, interpret and evaluate written language, symbols and text with understanding and fluency
Writing	Engage in written communication in a variety of situations for a variety of purposes and audiences
Speaking	Engage in oral communication in a variety of situations for a variety of purposes and audiences
