The Day Before:

- Sign up for remind so that I can text you to remind you to set an alarm (see the packet you were given).
- Know that 5-121 is your testing location

The Day Of Your Test:

- Dress in layers! T-shirt, sweats, jacket.....
- Leave all electronic devices LOCKED in your car or at home.
No watches allowed! NO HEADPHONES! NO PHONES!!!!
- Know your testing location: 5-121
- ARRIVE EARLY!
- You are responsible for the information on your packet!
- The ending time for your exams are estimated.

- You ID Candidate number is located on the top of your examination schedule and begins with “hlj.”
- Example: hlj243

Answer Booklets

- You may use as many answer booklets as necessary to complete your test.
- Be sure to write the question number in the box and all answers on the lines. You can use multiple boxes per question, but must label each box with the question number.
- If you make a mistake on a question and need to start over, put a line through your work and begin again in another boxed area. Put a line through any work you do not want counted toward your score.
- If you leave information out of an answer number another box with the same number and continue.
- Do not write outside of any boxes or outside of the lines.

Test Day Procedures

- You **MUST** arrive at least 10 minutes before your examination
- You **MUST** enter the room in a quiet and orderly manner
- Once you have entered, the exam is considered to be in progress. **THERE IS NO TALKING!**
- **NO WATCHES**, unless analog
- **NO ELECTRONICS**

During the Examination:

- If an alarm or code red occurs, you are NOT ALLOWED TO TALK AT ANYTIME WHILE OUT OF THE ROOM OR IN THE HARD CORNER. If you talk your exam score will be cancelled.
- Candidates are not permitted to leave the room during the first hour or last 15 minutes of the examination period. Candidates are NOT allowed to leave the room if the duration of the examination IS 1 HOUR AND 15 MINUTES OR LESS.
- If you become ill during the examination, you must let your invigilator know.

At the end of the examination

- You must sit quietly while all testing materials are collected.
- You may not leave the room until the invigilators dismiss you.
- You may not discuss or share the content of the examination verbally or through any electronic means.


