Every day, more network security compromises occur across the country and the State of Delaware's K12 network is not immune to these vulnerabilities. The State of Delaware's new Delaware Identity System leverages modern technologies such as artificial intelligence (AI) to secure ALL K12 information and ***will replace the existing legacy single sign-on portal on August 1st, 2021.***

All Smyrna School District staff must register for a Delaware ID. Your Delaware ID lets you easily access State services and managed applications like PHRST employee benefits and payroll information. Your Delaware ID provides:

- Ability to **unlock your own account**, to change or reset your own password and multifactor authentication factors.
- **Easy access** to State of Delaware secure applications (No need for employee ID to login)
- **Worldwide access** to your Delaware ID-protected account via a simple URL, <https://id.delaware.gov>

Visit <https://id.delaware.gov> and follow the simple online prompts to register.
