



1. Underneath the Drilldown Report click on the Interactive Summary Report.






3. On this page there is a legend that identifies how responses are coded based on the percent of students answering the item correctly. The columns break it down further by individual response rates and which distractors proved more troublesome for students. It defines which items were easy, medium or hard and by clicking on the number you can even look at the actual test item.



4. By clicking on the category or subcategory you are able to see more information on which skills are measured in that standard and what resources are available.



5. By clicking on the + symbol to the right of your answer choice you are able to see who specifically chose what answer in your class.



6. Also located at the top of this screen is a sort function where you can see clusters of information about student responses and other features.
