- ★ i-Ready is an online reading program that helps teachers determine students' personalized learning needs
- ★ Teachers monitor students' progress throughout the school year.
- \star *i-Ready* allows teachers to meet students exactly where they are
- ★ i-Ready provides data to increase students' achievement
- ★ i-Ready consists of two parts: Diagnostic and Instruction

IREADY READING COMPONENTS

i-Ready Diagnostic

- An adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit students' needs.
- Each item a student sees is individualized based on their answer to the previous question.
- The purpose of the diagnostic is to determine how best to support each individual student's learning.

i-Ready Instruction

- Provides students with lessons based on their individual skill level and needs
- Students can learn at a pace that is just right for them.
- The lessons are fun and interactive in order to keep students engaged as they learn.


Typical Growth


★ The average annual growth for students at each grade and placement level


Stretch Growth







TIPS TO SUPPORT MY CHILD'S LEARNING

- ★ Speak with your child about how using i-Ready will help them prepare for class work.
- ★ Encourage your child to take each lesson and quiz question seriously.
- ★ Emphasize "thinking before clicking," because just clicking through will not give teachers an accurate report of what your child knows.
- ★ Encourage your child to use the tools that appear at the bottom of the screen in some lessons.
- ★ Help your child identify and become familiar with the different parts of the student dashboard.
- ★ Track and celebrate your child's progress. (Aim for 45 minutes-per subject per week while passing at least 70 percent of lessons.
- Contact your child's teacher about how often your child should practice at home, or with any other questions about i-Ready
