

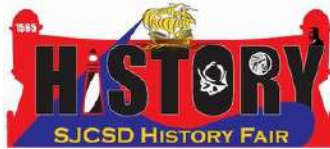
## ARE YOU MOVING? WITHDRAWING YOUR STUDENT?

## ADDRESS CHANGE REQUIREMENTS

In order to update your child's record, SJCSJ now requires you to complete a "Student Change of Address Form". Along with the completed and signed form, you must submit the following:

Mortgage Statement/Property Deed/  
Settlement statement/Closing documents

**\*OR\***

Lease/Rental Agreement with names of occupants  
(And, if applicable, a Homeowners Acknowledgment Form and Affidavit of Residency Form)



You must also provide TWO of the following documents:

Utility Bill, Property Tax Record, Telephone/Cell phone Statement, Homeowners/Renters Insurance Documents, Bank Statement/Paycheck Stub, Vehicle Registration, Credit Card Statement, Medical Insurance Statement – all showing the new address.

In addition, you must show a valid photo ID/drivers license.

## LITERACY WEEK ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS

**K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade:** students will read stories focusing on changing the world, discuss as a group, participate in writing original books based on the theme.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade:** students will: **brainstorm** problems in our world, **research** for understanding and discuss possible solutions, **create and present** solutions using media center makerspace materials

# Legos and Literature Contest

## Deadline: January 23 - 26

The Patriot Oaks Media Center is hosting a Legos and Literature contest during Literacy Week. Charger students are invited to create a Lego display that depicts a scene or character from a favorite book. Bring in your project to the POA media center and enter it into our contest during the week of January 23-26. All entries must be received by 3:00 on January 26 to be eligible for prizes.

### Contest Rules:

1. Build a LEGO creation that represents a character, setting, or any other feature from a favorite book.
  2. Students must use LEGO pieces from home and must create their LEGO display outside of school.
  3. Commercially-made characters may be used as part of a larger *original/literature-based* LEGO display. (Ex.- a Harry Potter LEGO piece may be used, as long as it's as part of a larger Hogwarts castle *display that you create*.)
  4. LEGO creations may be completed by individuals or groups of students.
  5. LEGO creations must fit on a base no larger than a 12" square.
  6. LEGO creations can be stationary or include movement.
  7. To enter a LEGO display, complete the entry form and turn it in to your teacher no later than Friday, January 13. Only the entry card needs to be turned in by Jan. 13. Actual LEGO displays will be brought to school media center the week of January 23.
  8. Print out a color copy of your book's cover (from Amazon, Google images, etc.) and place it in the top-right corner of the entry form.
  9. All LEGO displays must be taken home on Friday, February 3, except for the 3 winning LEGO creations which will be displayed in the trophy case.
  10. Winners will be announced on January 27. The top three (3) LEGO displays will be selected by a panel of judges. Winning LEGO creators and their LEGO displays will be featured in the Patriots Press Newsletter and presented with a special certificate! Winning displays will be chosen based on *originality and creativity*.
  11. Prizes: Three winners will be chosen to receive \$25 worth of Book Bucks for the Spring Book Fair.
