<p>PAWS</p> <p>Date Jan. 25</p>	<p><i>Dual Enrollment Info</i></p>  <p>Dual Enrollment Activity (YouScience)</p> <p>Dual Enrollment Verification Survey</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Dual Enrollment is a program funded by the Georgia Department of Education in which high school students can earn college and high school credit at the same time. The State of Georgia allows for students to receive funding for up to 30 credit hours of Dual Enrollment courses based on grade level eligibility. At Camden County High School, we have partnered with Coastal Pines Technical College to offer Core Academic Dual Enrollment courses as well as CTAE Dual Enrollment classes. At this time, advisors will allow all students to view a clip titled “Dual Enrollment” to learn more about how Dual Enrollment courses have impacted others. <u>Dual Enrollment Clip</u> 2) After viewing the video clip for Dual Enrollment, ALL 9th Grade students will sign into their student PowerSchool Account to complete a REQUIRED brief activity on Dual Enrollment. (A list of PS Login’s for Advisory Students has been placed in advisor’s mailbox). <p>Students can use the video tutorial below or the electronic directions to complete the Dual Enrollment Activity. PLEASE NOTE: If using the video tutorial, understand that it was made for 11th graders however the directions on how to complete the Dual Enrollment activity are compatible for 9th graders.
