What is Jet Jamboree?

Jet Jamboree is a school-wide rewards system that takes place at the end of each quarter. Students earn points throughout the quarter and redeem them for various activities at Jet Jamboree, including games, snack booths, and the Jet store. The more points earned, the more activities they can participate in.

How does my student earn points?



Throughout the quarter, teachers will track student's attendance, classwork, and behavior <u>daily</u>, earning points from four different components for a total of <u>up to 4 points each day!</u>

ATTENDANCE: Arrive in the classroom by 7:50 am = 2 points


ATTENDANCE: Arrive in the classroom after 7:50 am = 1 point

CLASSWORK: Complete and turn in all classwork = 1 point

BEHAVIOR: Demonstrate Choose Love Ingredients

(BPES Behavior Matrix & GLOs) = 1 point

Bonus Points: During resource day (SEL, P.E., Art, and Coding), students will be able to gain one bonus point from **each** resource teacher if their whole class has good behavior.
