This process impacts jobs at our school because we must have qualified staff to teach the classes that we need. We will not allow for schedule changes at the beginning of next school year because students have changed their minds. Our classes are typically scheduled to capacity when we build the schedule.

To select the appropriate classes for next year, students need to review the Curriculum Guide, attend the Husky Highlight Curriculum Night, and talk to their teachers to select their classes. Please make sure that students also include a few elective classes as alternates because we will not be able to meet all requests and will have to place them in some of their alternative selections. Our schedule is complex, and we do our best to meet the requests that students make during registration.
