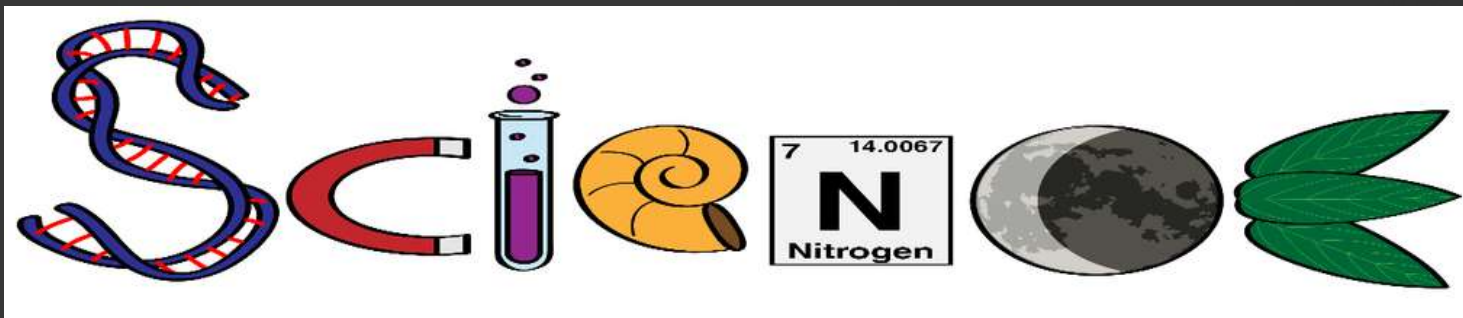

I hope that you and your family have a wonderful 2017 filled with good health and blessings.

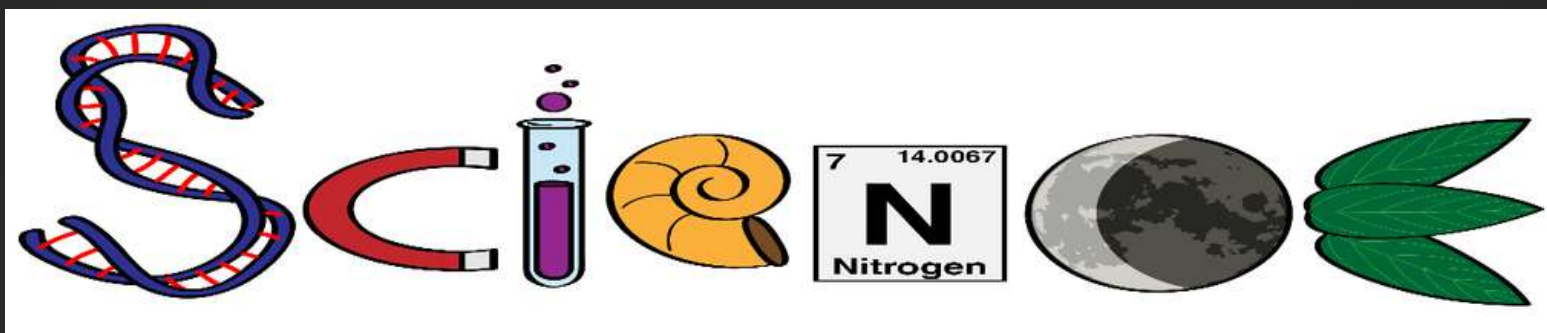


Happy New Year and Greetings from the ninth grade science teachers!
