Dear Parents and Students of BETA Club.

Congratulations on being a part of the National Junior BETA Club. We are excited to have the opportunity to work with such fine young men and women at Eagle's Landing Middle School.

Every year the National Junior BETA Club hosts a state convention where Junior BETA members from all over the state compete in various competitions. This year the convention will be held in Savannah, Georgia on November 29th - December 1st.

We would like to give our students at ELMS the opportunity to attend the state competition. This is a wonderful and prestigious event and experience for our students.

We are holding a very important parent meeting on Wednesday October 4 at 5:30-6:00pm in the school's Media Center. If at all possible please plan to attend with your BETA student as I will share very important information about the trip. Even if you are unsure your child will attend please come so that you will be aware of the cost and details of the trip. (This is on the same day we are also holding our first student meeting 4:15-5:15 pm).

Cost Estimates:

- 1. **\$50 required registration fee** students
- 2. \$30.00 for lunch and dinner on Wednesday November 29th and on Thursday, November 30th. Breakfast is free at the hotel.
- 3. Hotel cost is \$80.00 per person (3 person occupancy).
- 4. **Bus Charter Cost**: Depending on if we have enough students/parents to attend (at least 50 people) our cost for the bus will be around **\$85.00** per person.

Total cost estimates: \$245.00

- All Prices are Per Person and are subject to change depending on the number of students who attend the conference.
- We truly hope students will be able to attend as this is a great experience for students to meet with other BETA Members across the state and engage in competitions to spark their learning.
