The Woodland Middle School National Junior Beta Club is an honor organization that recognizes outstanding academic achievement, promotes strong moral character and social responsibility, encourages service to others, fosters leadership skills, and provides settings for you to develop strong interpersonal skills.

Who qualifies for membership in the WMS JUNIOR BETA CLUB?

Seventh and eighth grade students with a grade point average of 3.5 or above (End of the Year Average from the 08-09 school year), who also exemplify strong character, and have maintained role model behavior (No behavioral referrals) throughout the last school year are eligible to apply for membership. Sixth grade students who are current members of Junior Beta Clubs from an elementary school will be allowed to transfer membership into the WMS Junior Beta Club. New sixth grade members will be eligible for membership in the spring the current school year.

What are the requirements of membership?

Each member must attend at least two-thirds of our monthly meetings and participate in at least two service projects. Students are strongly encouraged to participate in as many projects as possible since this is the key to leadership development within our organization. Academic progress and behavioral records will be checked each grading period in order for students to maintain active membership.

What are the dues for members?

There is a one-time fee of \$30 collected prior to induction. This includes a national induction fee, local dues, and club t-shirt. Local dues are payable at the beginning of each year of membership and are used to pay for club expenses during the year, while the national induction fee is a one-time fee. Transfer members will only pay the annual local dues of \$18, which includes a club t-shirt.

How do I apply for membership?

If the final report card from the sixth or seventh grade reflects a 3.5 grade point average, and you desire to fulfill the Beta Club participation and service requirements, please complete the attached application form and ask two teachers to complete the attached recommendation forms. At least one of the recommending teachers should be from last year, unless you are new to Woodland Middle School. If you are new to WMS, please give each form to a current teacher.

Transfer applicants (from other schools or elementary schools) are required to also fill out the applications and recommendation forms, submit a copy of last year's report card, and a copy of the membership card. The final report card from the 07-08 school year must also reflect a 3.5grade point average.

Applications and teacher recommendations must be given directly to Ms. Lashone Smith (Room 813) or placed in their mailbox in the office no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 9, 2009.

How will I know I have been accepted into the Beta Club?

Invitations for accepted students will be distributed during homeroom on Thursday, October 16, 2009.
