ALL FEES MUST BE PAID ONLINE OR BY MONEY ORDERS. NO CASH OR CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED. THERE WILL BE A \$20 LATE FEE FOR EACH MONTH AFTER FEBRUARY. ALL JUNIORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR JUNIOR/SENIOR PROM FEES WHETHER THEY PLAN TO ATTEND THE PROM OR NOT.

Junior Fees

- All 11th graders are required to pay junior fees.
- Payment of your junior fees grants you access to the prom, however, not going to the prom does not relieve you of the obligation to pay junior fees.
 - As an 11th grade student, you have the responsibility of hosting the prom, whether you plan to attend or not.
- Like senior fees, junior fees are a package price. You cannot choose a la carte items from the package.
- All junior fees are due by February 5, 2016. A monthly late fee will be charged each month on the 6th day of the month beginning February 6, 2016. Payment can be made online or by money order. Money order payments are to be made to Ms. Mayes.

Junior/Senior Prom

- The prom is only open to 11th and 12th grade students. No 9th or 10th grade students are allowed to attend the prom.
- Payment of your junior fees grants admission for the paying student and one guest. No guests over the age of 21 will be admitted. All BTW students must pay their junior fees in order to attend. A non-paying student may not attend the prom as the guest of a paying student.
- The Junior Senior Prom fee must be paid before a student will be cleared to graduate as a senior.
