PURPOSE The Benjamin Cummings Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by the College Park Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. Scholarship Committee in honor of Mr. Benjamin Cummings. Mr. Cummings was a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. and a staunch believer in higher achievement. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to senior male high school students that will be attending a Historically Black College or University (HBCU).

Preference will be given to high school senior students however; consideration is also given to first and second year male students and as well as graduate students enrolled in an HBCU.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership potential, community involvement, and enrollment into an HBCU. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The College Park Alumni Chapter (CPAC) of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. Scholarship Committee awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, and a Personal Essay. CPAC pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient. Scholarships are awarded annually. CPACS' Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, and/or handicap. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, it will be awarded directly to the recipient.
- Kappa League Student of the Year Competition Award Winners are not eligible for this scholarship. (i.e. Student must not have received funds previously from the Kappa League Student of the Year Competition).
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by June 4th, 2021.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due June 4th, 2021 of the current calendar year.
- Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship Committee at their discretion.
- · Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by Corey Davis.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- A Personal Essay (see item#21 below for the instructions and topic)
- A recent photo or headshot.
- · Official proof of academic standing.
- A letter of academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A letter completed reference from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance or enrollment at an HBCU for post-secondary studies. Proof of acceptance/attendance can come from dorm room assignment and/or receipt from the dorm deposit.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Awards will be given by June 2021.
- Award amounts will be distributed annually after all requirements are met.
