WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A TITLE I SCHOOL?



BEHAVIOR & COMMUNICATION

- YOUR CHILD HAS A BEHAVIOR COMMUNICATION SHEET IN HIS/HER DAILY FOLDER. WE ARE
 FOLLOWING THE CONSCIOUS DISCIPLINE PROTOCOL FOR REDIRECTION, MODELING, AND
 TRYING AGAIN.
- SIGN YOUR CHILD'S BEHAVIOR SHEET DAILY AND DISCUSS SUCCESSES AND CHALLENGES TOGETHER.
- REPEATED MISBEHAVIOR MAY RESULT IN A BEHAVIOR PLAN FOR YOUR CHILD.

HOW TO SUPPORT YOUR STUDENT

- WORK WITH YOUR CHILD AT HOME
- VOLUNTEER IN THE SCHOOL
- COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR CHILD AND SCHOOL STAFF

HOMEWORK

- HOMEWORK CAN BE FOUND IN YOUR CHILD'S DAILY COMMUNICATION FOLDER.
- CHECK YOUR CHILD'S HOMEWORK CALENDAR AND HELP HIM/HER WITH THE ASSIGNED
 ACTIVITY. THESE REVOLVE AROUND WHAT WE ARE LEARNING IN CLASS AND ARE MEANT TO
 SUPPORT LEARNING.
- IN ADDITION, YOUR CHILD HAS TWO BOOKS IN HIS/HER FOLDER. READ THESE BOOKS EACH NIGHT. BE SURE TO PUT THE BOOKS BACK IN THE BOOK BAGGY IN THE FOLDER SO THAT BOOKS CAN BE EXCHANGED EACH WEEK.

- SUPPORT HOMEWORK BLOCKS
- MAKE SCHOOL YOUR CHILD'S "JOB"
