

















# Transportation Information




 Drop-off and Pick-up procedures will come home the first day of school.





Circus Themed Obstacle Course: (supports following directions)


- · Drop a parachute (plastic bag) and slide down the slide

Fine Motor Skills Development (supports scissors skills)






#### Summer Kindergarten Readiness Activities
