

Putting the Child First

Dear Parents:

In order for your child to be enrolled in a Henry County School for the 2007-2008 school year, you will need to provide required documents to the school. Failure to provide needed information may results in delays in assigning teachers or classes for your child.

Students attending Georgia public schools must have on file certifications of immunization and examination. An additional MMR booster and Varicella Immunization or documentation of the history of this disease (recorded on Form 3231) is required for students entering Kindergarten, 6th grade, and new entrants (defined as any child entering any school or facility in Georgia for the first time or after havh'1g been absent from a Georgia facility for more that 12 months or one school year).

Please contact your doctor or the Henry County Health Department for further details about immunization requirements for your child.

The following documents that are checked below are not currently on file:

- ___ Georgia Certificate of Immunization, Form 3231
- ___ Georgia Eye, Ear, and Dental Certificate, Form 3300
- ___ Georgia MMR Vaccine Certificate, Form 3189 or 3231
- Georgia Chicken Pox (Varicella) Immunization, Form 3189 or 3231
- ____A copy of the child's birth certificate or other proof of age
- ____ A copy of the child's Social Security Card
- ____ Waiver or other document for _____
- ___ Guardianship or Custody Documentation
- ___ Residency Information for the custodial parents
- __ Grade Placement Information or Report Card

*Waiver or other document may include a medical or religious waiver regarding immunizations or a form instead of the social security number.

The Georgia Department of Human Resources periodically audits student files for up-to-date immunization certificates. Further, Georgia law, Georgia State Board rules, and Henry County Board policies require that these documents be on file with schools for students to be el1.Tolled
