Advanced Placement Test Performance

2021-2022 Data



Lake Brantley High School administered 2086 Advanced Placement exams in 29 courses (at no cost to students). The most popular AP courses are Human Geography, English Language and Composition, World History, Environmental Science, and Psychology.

LBHS had an average pass rate of 62% on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

All juniors and seniors at LBHS get an opportunity to take the SAT at no cost.

The average Lake Brantley High School SAT score is 1006 out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 983.

LBHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT at no cost.




LBHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of 943 out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 890.
