

## **Area: CAFETERIA**

<p><b>I Am Responsible</b></p> <p><i>Take care of myself and do my job</i></p>
<p><b>Teaching Examples</b></p> <p>Example: Sam has his lunch token ready to show the cafeteria workers.</p> <p>Non Example: Charles leaves his trash from his lunch box on the table.</p> <p>Example: The teacher calls for your attention. You immediately stop talking and look toward him/her to get the message.</p>
<p><b>Kid Activity</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Discuss cafeteria rules and why we have them.</li><li>2. Sign up to work in the cafeteria one day.</li><li>3. List “What do I need to do to get ready for the lunchroom?”</li></ol>
<p><b>After the Lesson</b> (During the Day)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Brainstorm ways being responsible is helpful to the cafeteria workers.</li><li>2. Have students put away classroom items carefully on a daily basis and keep their desks clean.</li></ol>
