Mathematics (Algebra 1 & Geometry)	3 credits
Science (Biology)	3 credits
Two credits in one of the specified programs of study:	
World Language (same language)	2 credits
Fine Arts	
Career & Technical Education	
Physical Education (P.E.)	1 credit
Health	0.5 credit
Personal Transition Plan	0.5 credit
Electives (Any Subject Area)	6 credits
TOTAL:	24 credits



Diploma Types

Academic Honors



Traditional diploma +

- 4 math credits (1 credit for Algebra 2 & 1 credit for math beyond Algebra 2)
- 4 science credits (1 credit in Biology or another equivalent science such as IB Biology or AP Biology)
- At least 2 AP/ IB/Running Start credits
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0+



Traditional diploma +

- 4 math credits (1 credit for Algebra 2 & 1 credit for math beyond Algebra 2)
- 4 science credits (1 credit in Biology)
- Successful completion of a STEM Capstone Project in one of the approved **ACCN** courses
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0+



Traditional diploma +

- Complete a program of study of 2 to 3 sequenced courses plus a specific state-identified academic course requirement
 - Must earn a B or better in <u>all</u> courses
 - Must meet or exceed proficiency on performancebased assessments for the selected program of study
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0+
