Why Take Fine Arts Courses?

- The 2010 College Board data shows students taking arts or music courses for four years scored higher on each of the SAT's writing, mathematics and reading sections compared to their counterparts with four years of courses in other liberal arts programs.
- Belonging to and participating in a co-curricular environment that fosters teamwork, individual accountability, work ethic, the understanding of belonging to an organization greater than oneself.
