COMMUNITY & SCHOOL

Leilehua High School, home of the Mighty Mules, was founded in 1924 and is located in Wahiawa, Hawai'i. Leilehua is approximately 22 miles from the capital city of Honolulu. Wahiawa is a medium sized community comprised of slightly more than 17,000 residents.

Leilehua High School is a public high school and is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges through 2025. Leilehua anchors the Leilehua Complex of Schools, which consists of the high school, two middle schools, and seven elementary schools. As of September 2022, LHS has an approximate enrollment of 1638 students in grades 9-12. LHS hosts a culturally diverse student body. The dominant ethnic groups are 30% Filipino, 23% Caucasian, and 16% Native Hawaiian. Due to its proximity to military installations, approximately 30% of the students' families serve in the US Military. Over 42% of our students qualify for the free/reduced lunch program, 7% receive ELL services, and 14% receive Special Education services.
