## COMMUNITY & SCHOOL

Leilehua High School, home of the Mighty Mules, was founded in 1924 and is located in Wahiawa, Hawai'i. Leilehua is approximately 22 miles from the capital city of Honolulu. Wahiawa is a medium sized community comprised of slightly more than 17,000 residents.

Leilehua High School is a public high school and is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges through 2025. Leilehua anchors the Leilehua Complex of Schools, which consists of the high school, two middle schools, and seven elementary schools. As of September 2021, LHS has an approximate enrollment of 1565 students in grades 9-12. LHS hosts a culturally diverse student body. The dominant ethnic groups are 27% Filipino, 22% Caucasian, and 18% Native Hawaiian. Due to its proximity to military installations, approximately 25% of the students' families serve in the US Military. Over 50% of our students qualify for the free/reduced lunch program, 7% receive ELL services, and 12% receive Special Education services.
